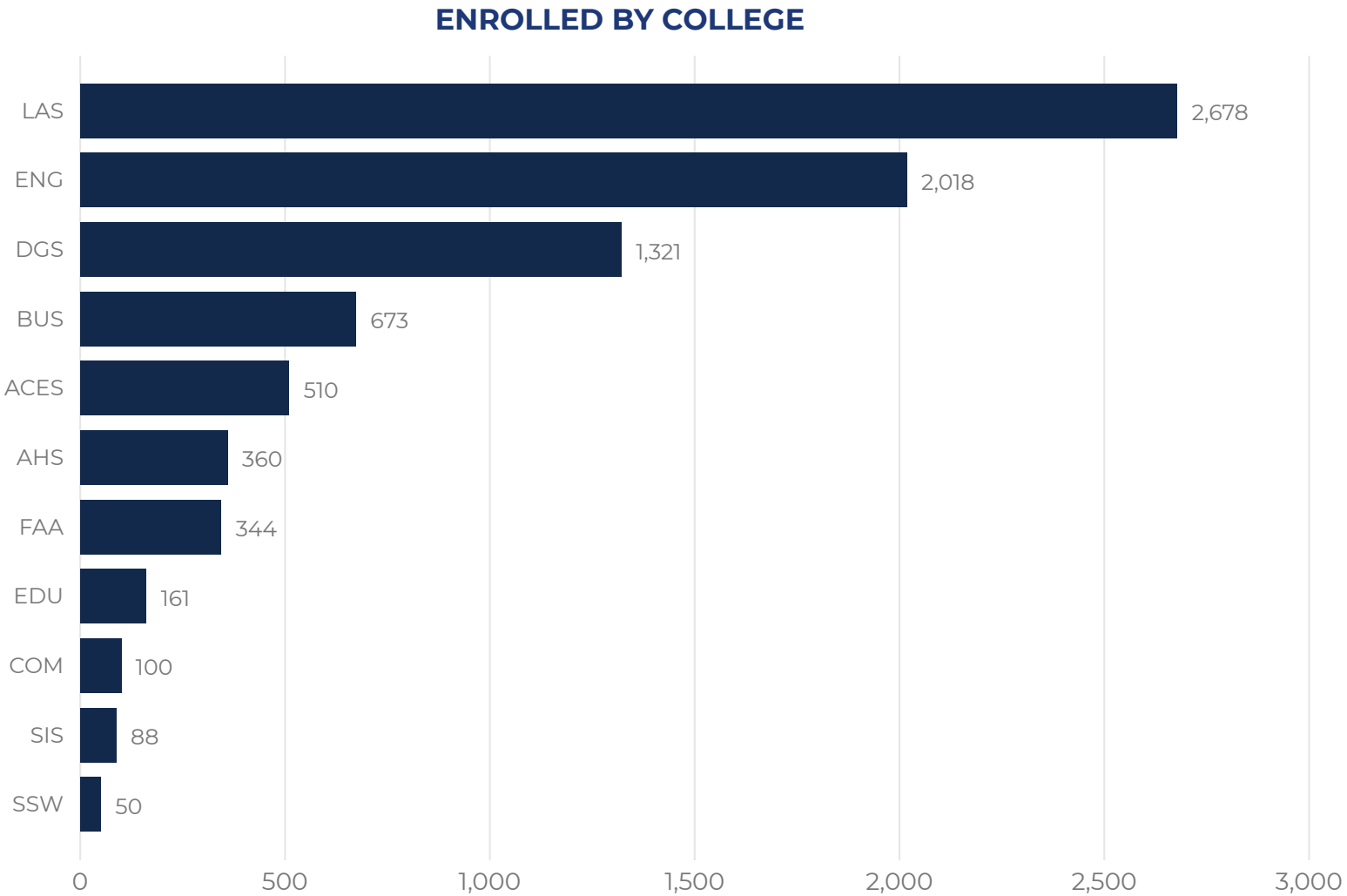

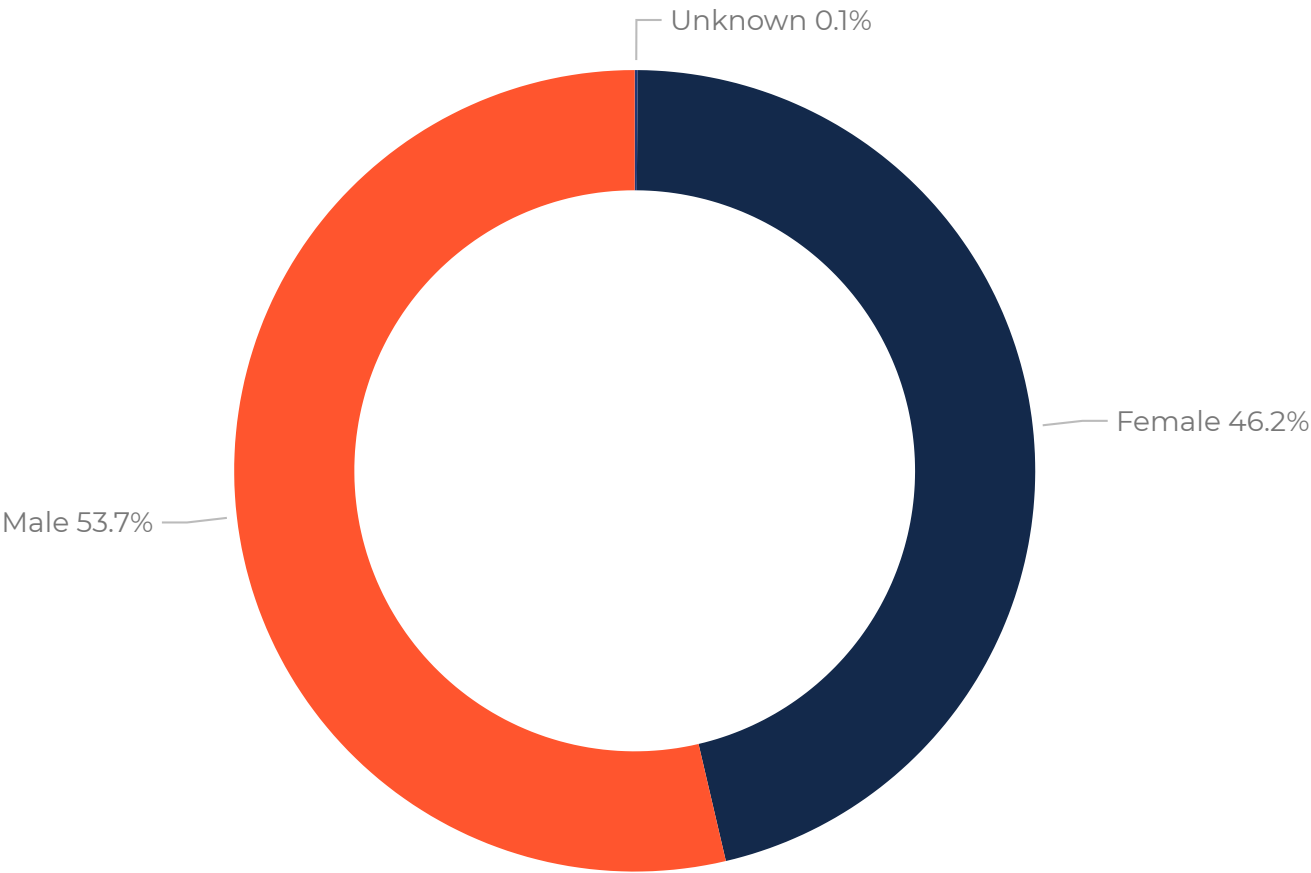

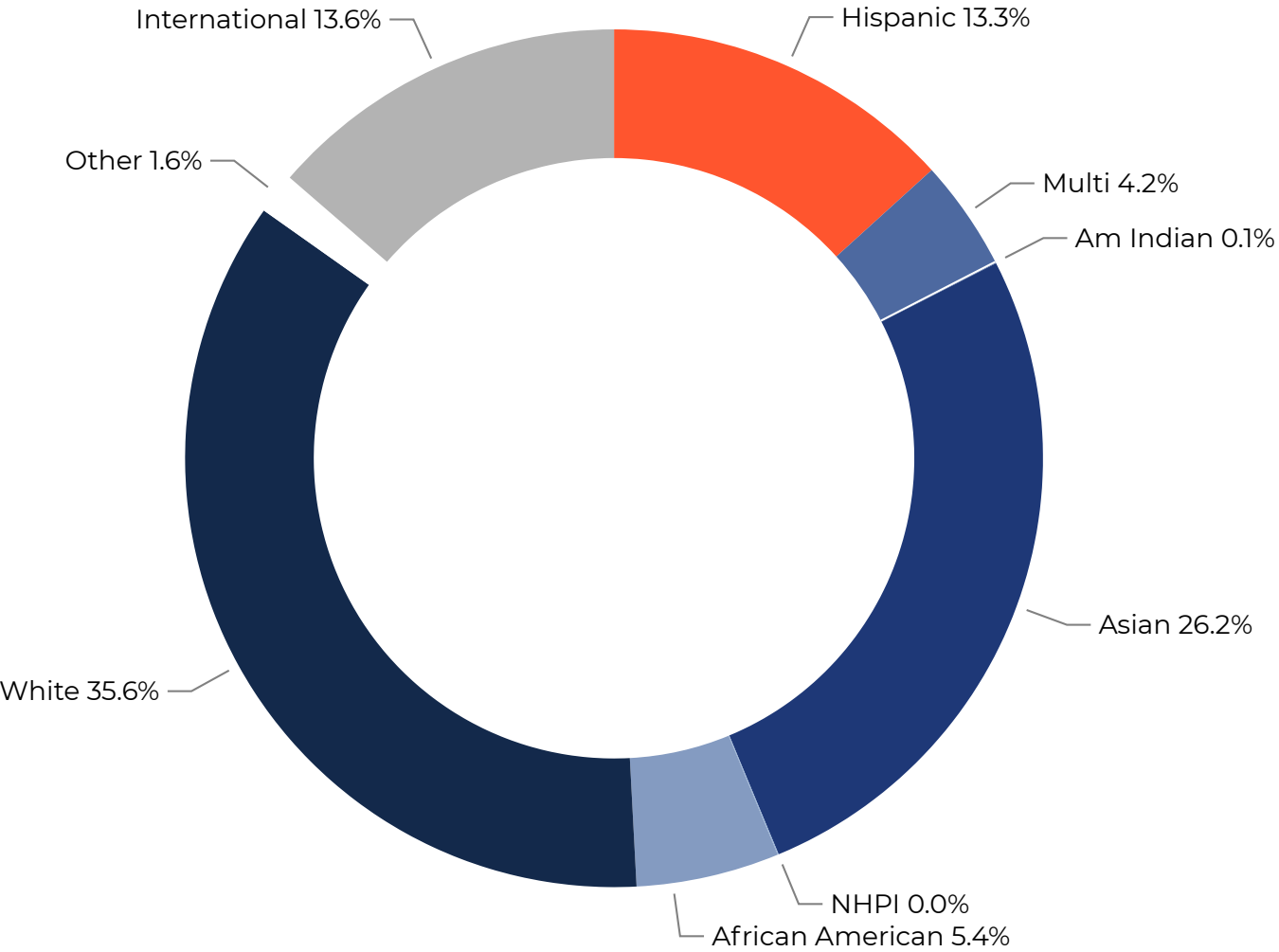

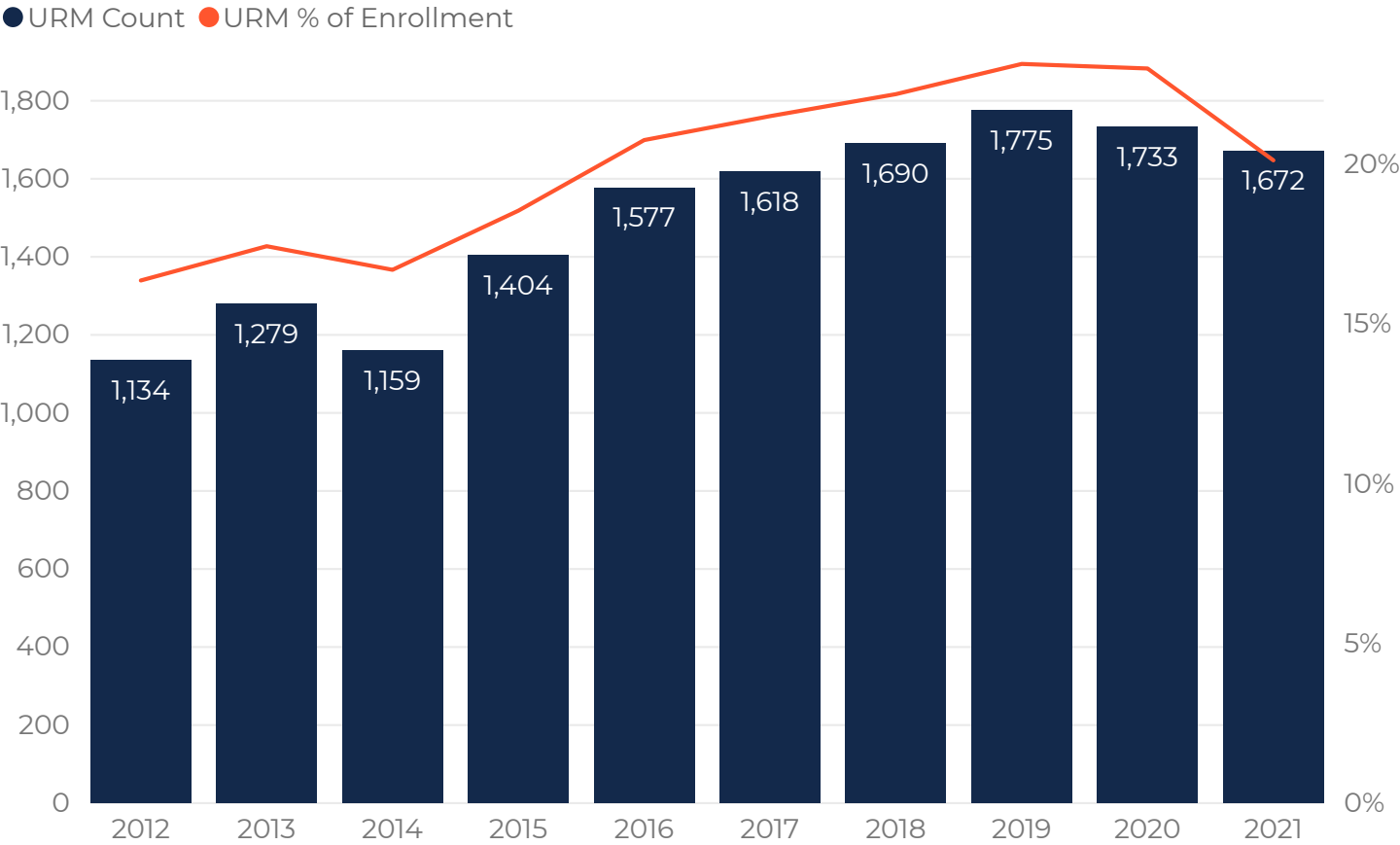

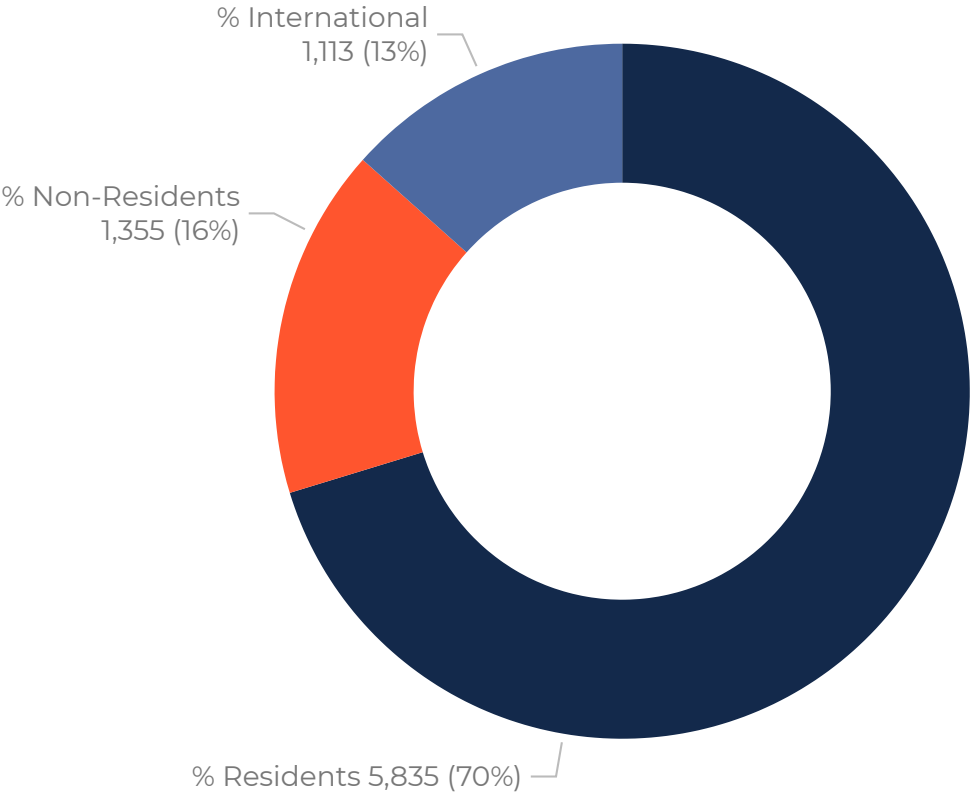

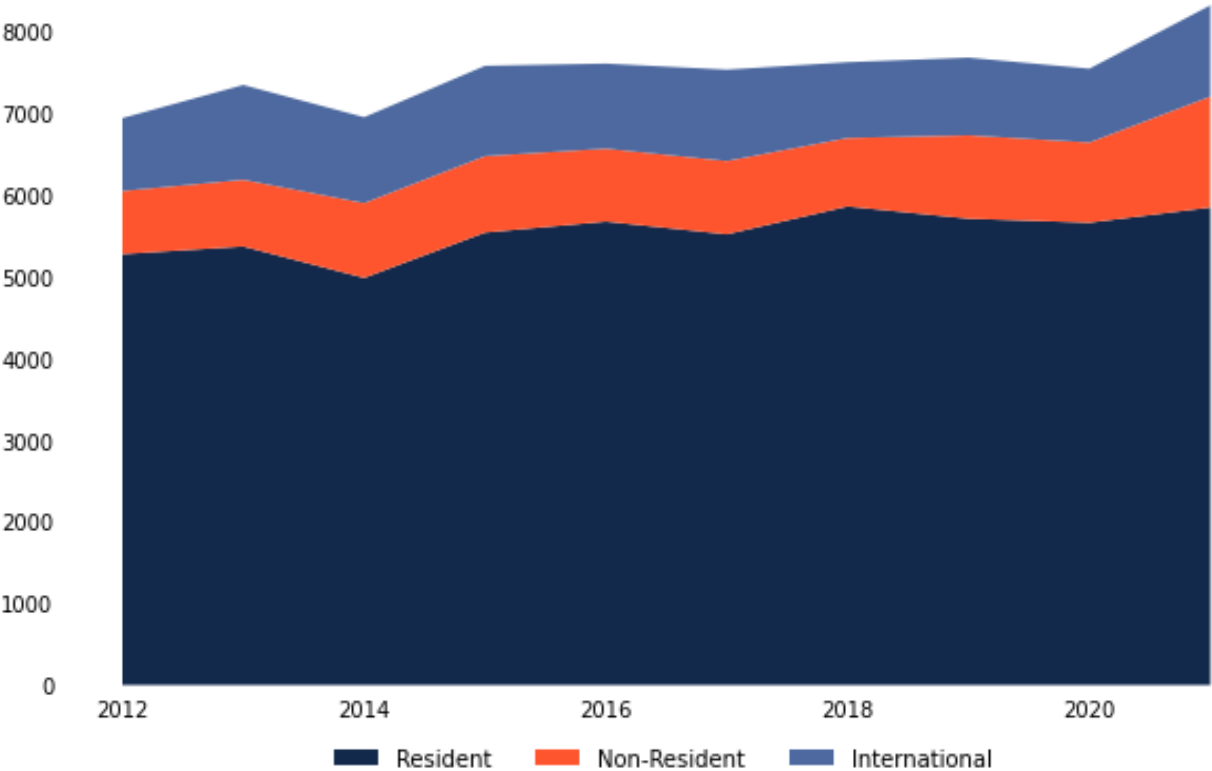

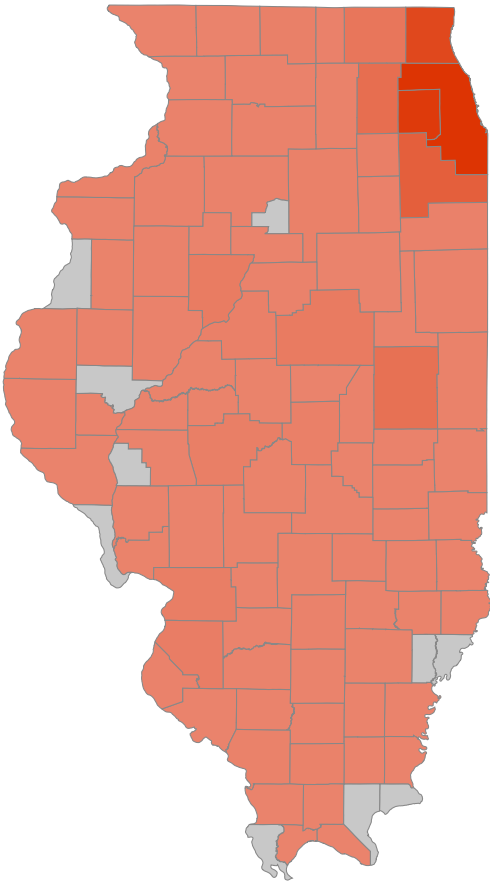

## TOP 10 FEEDER STATES OUTSIDE OF ILLINOIS

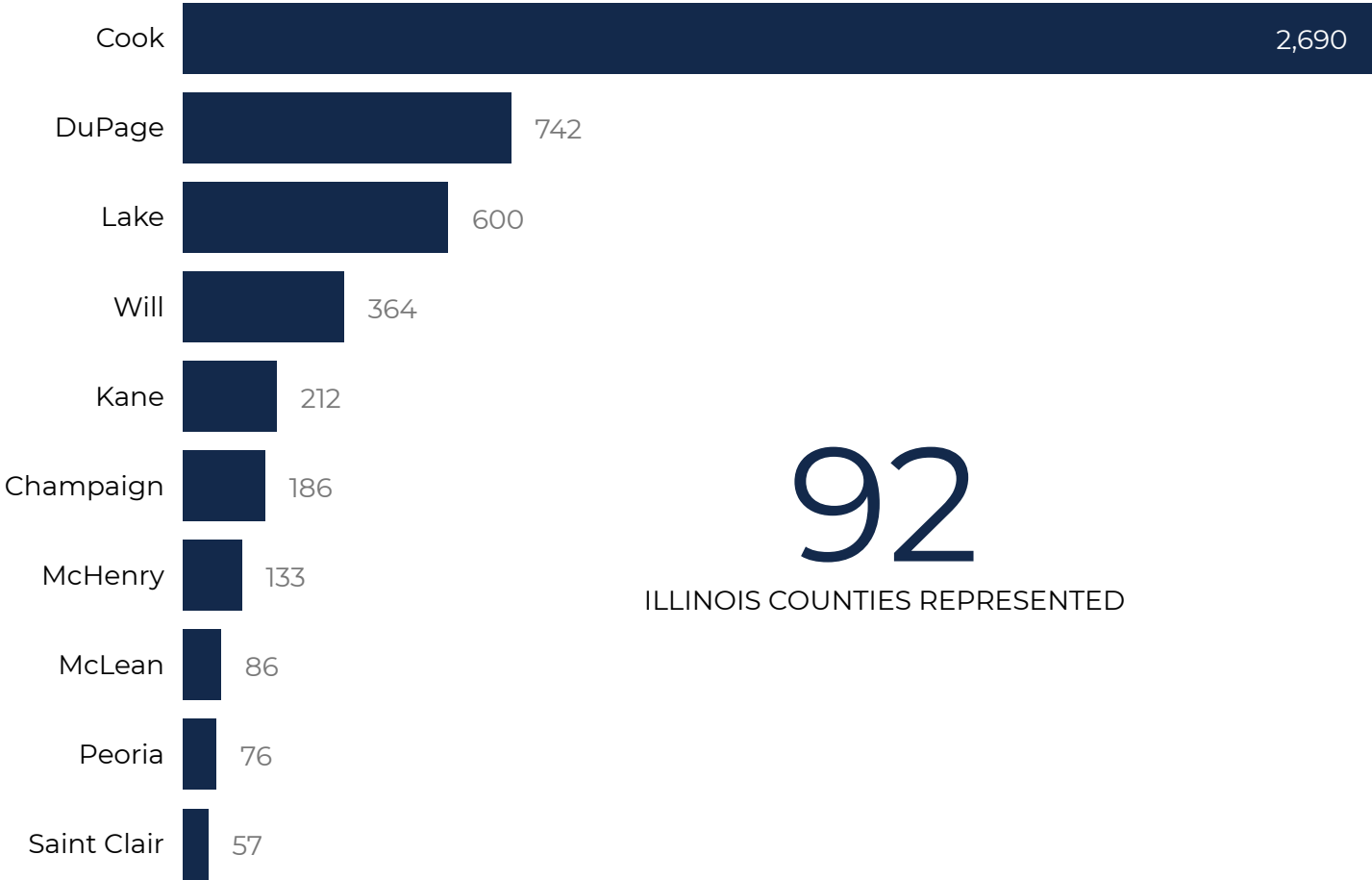

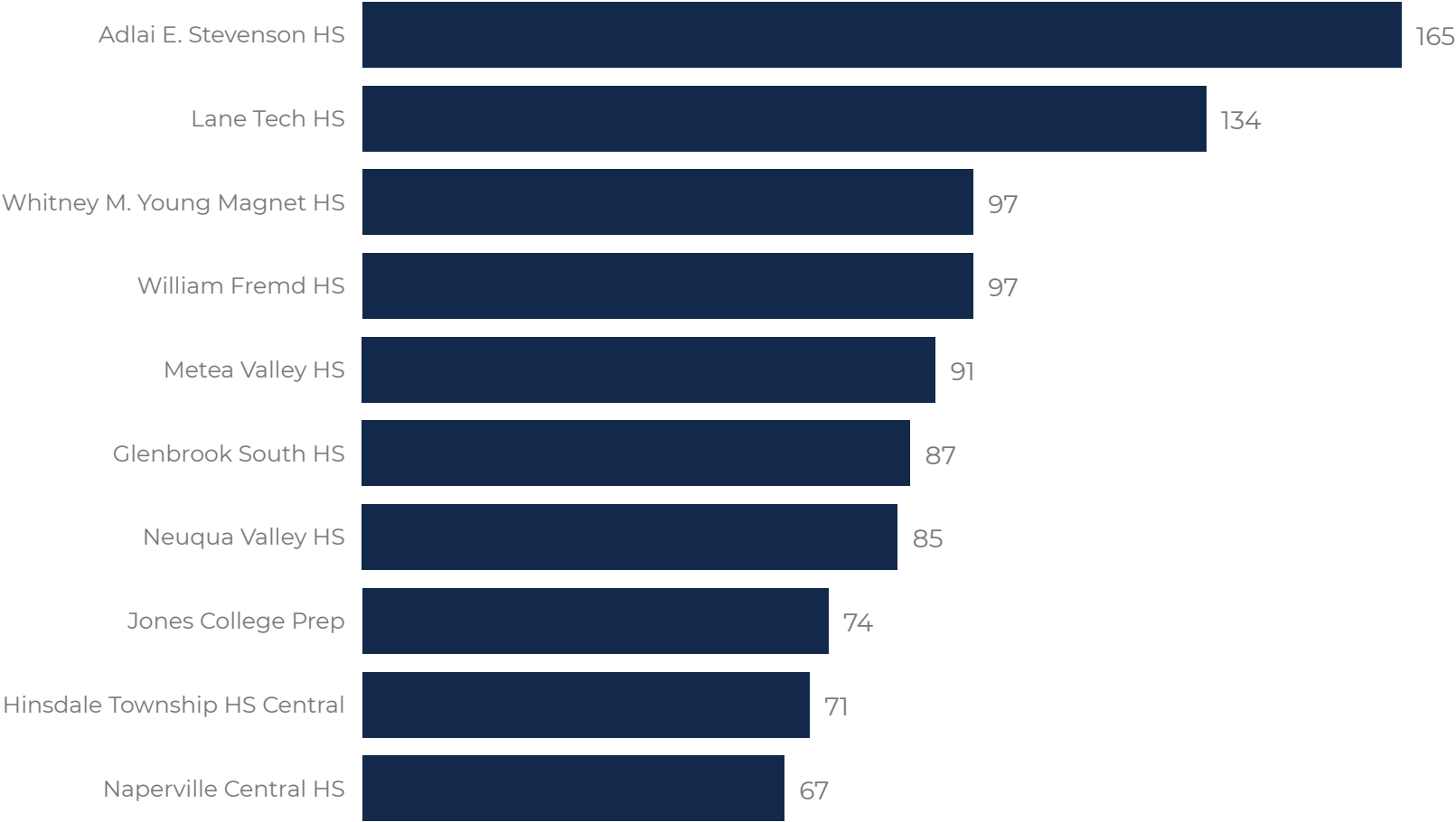

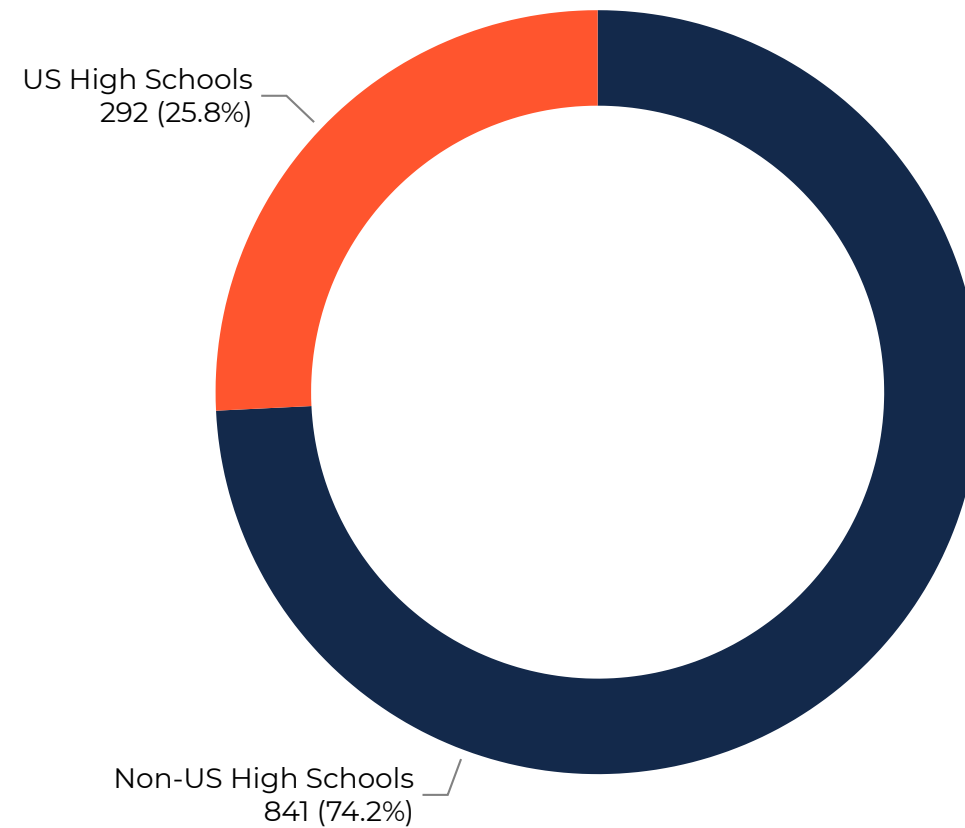




## ENROLLMENT BY % US HIGH SCHOOL

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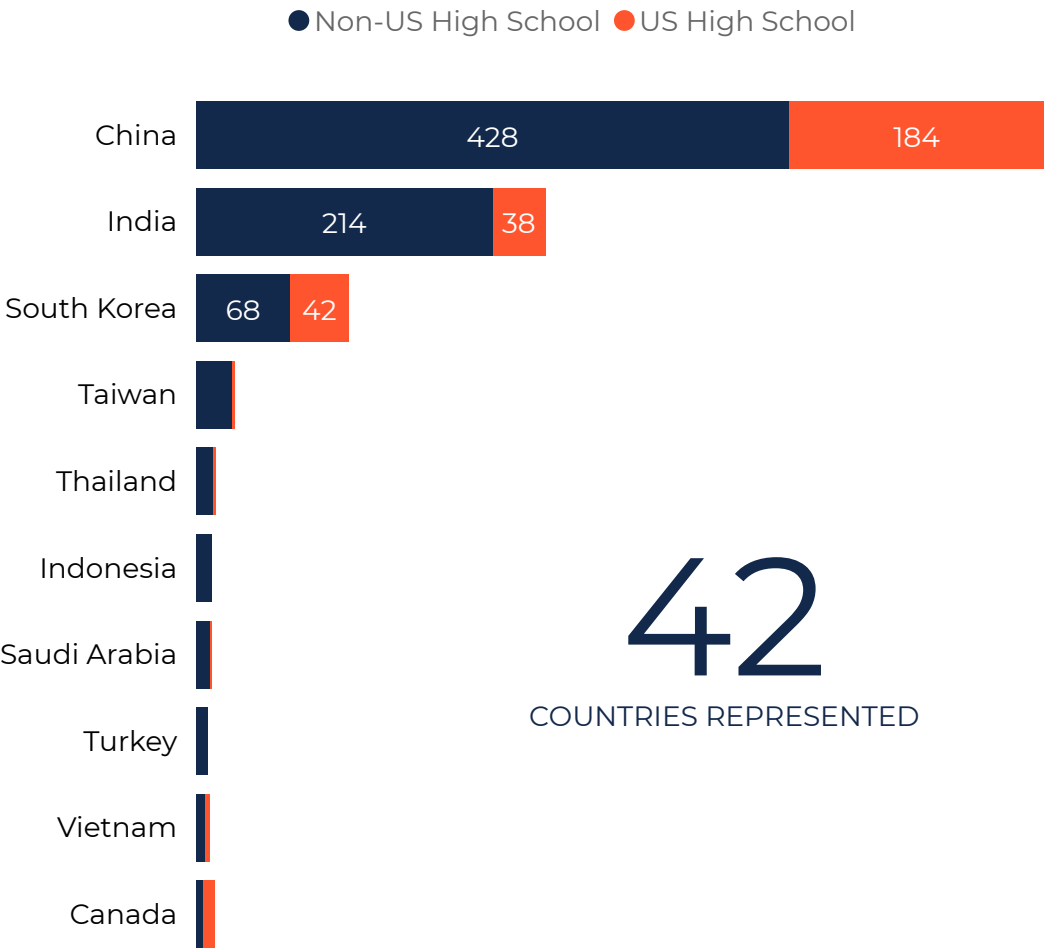
### % OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ATTENDING US HIGH SCHOOLS

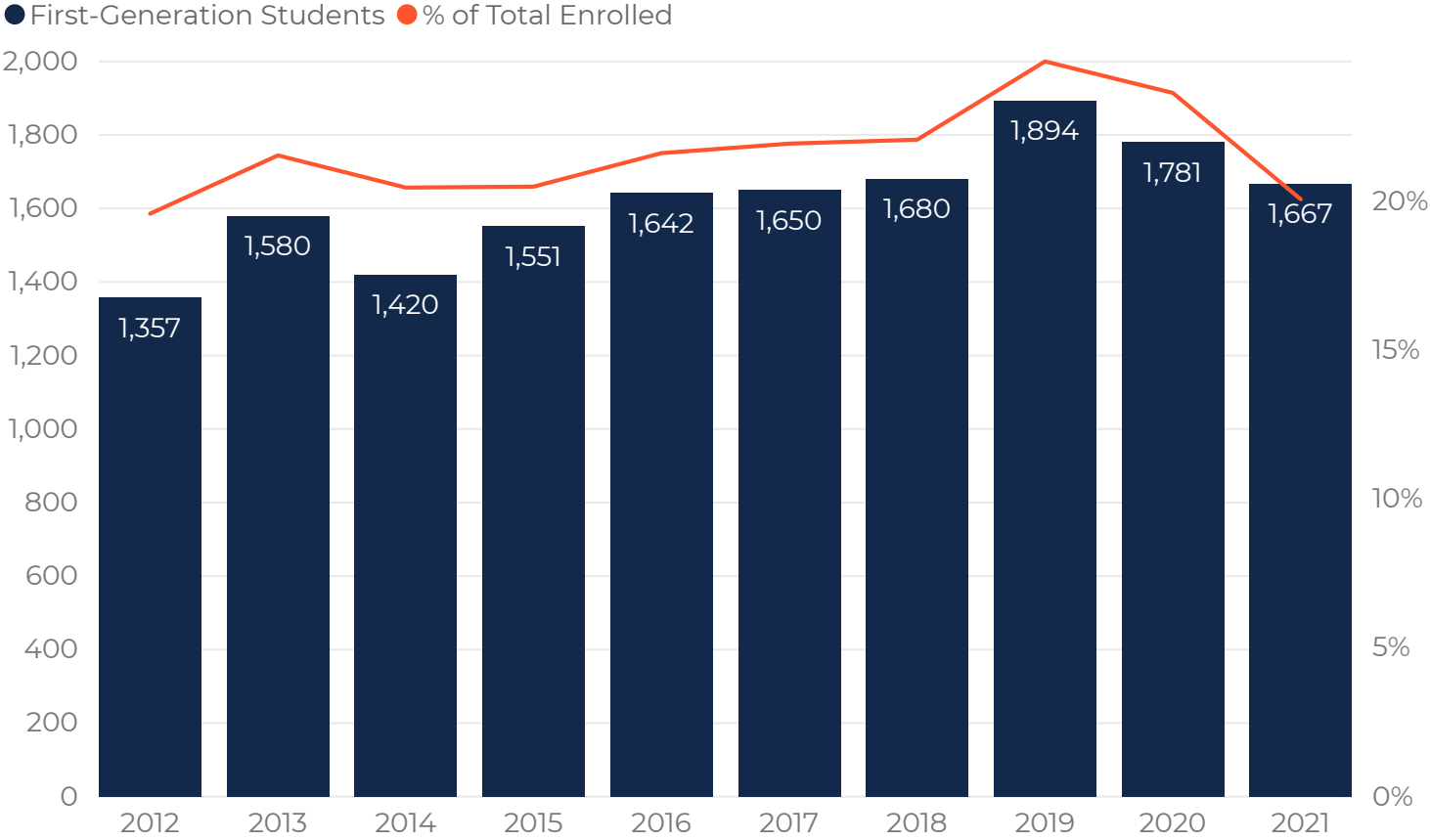

FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT COUNT, INCLUDING % OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT



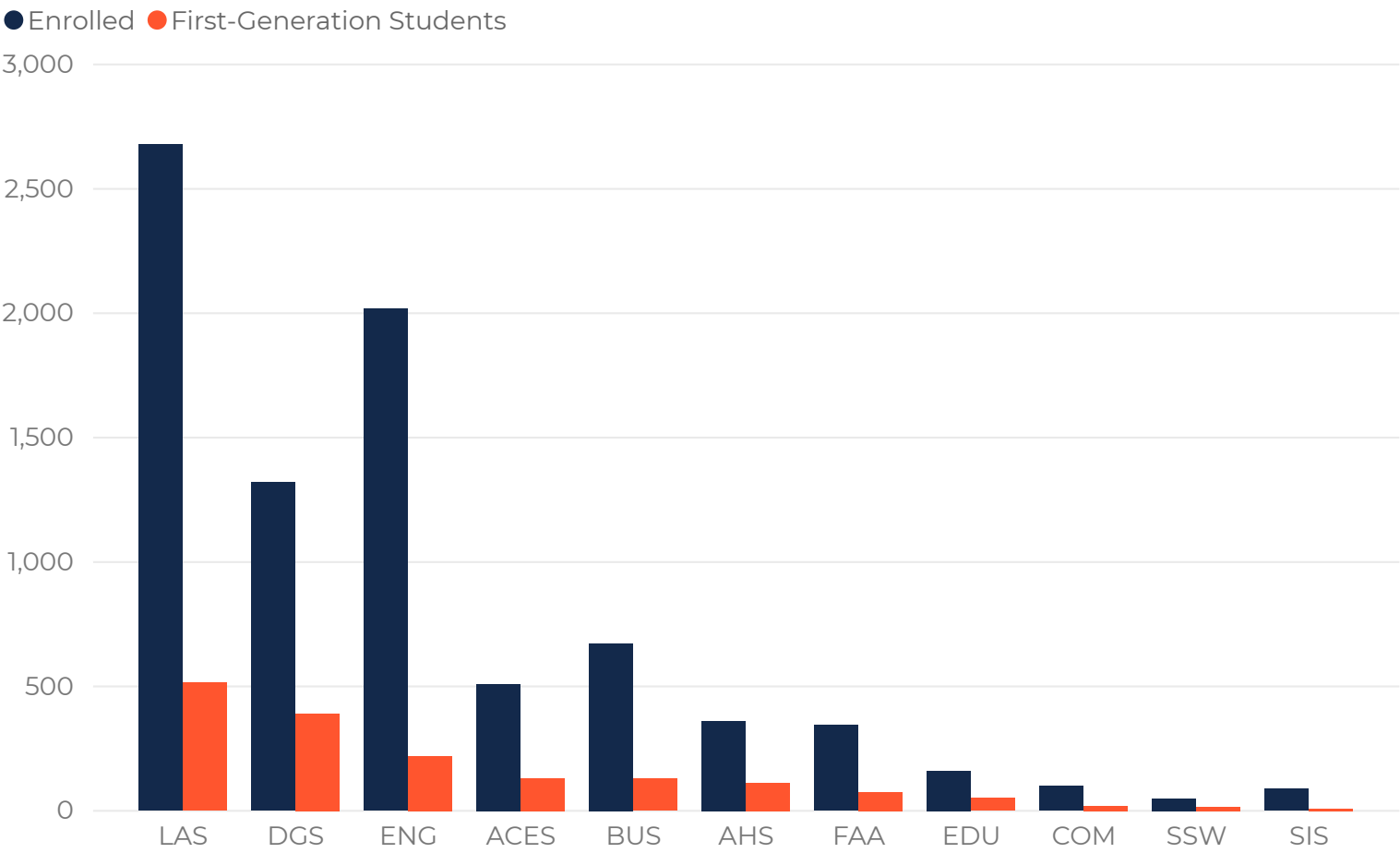

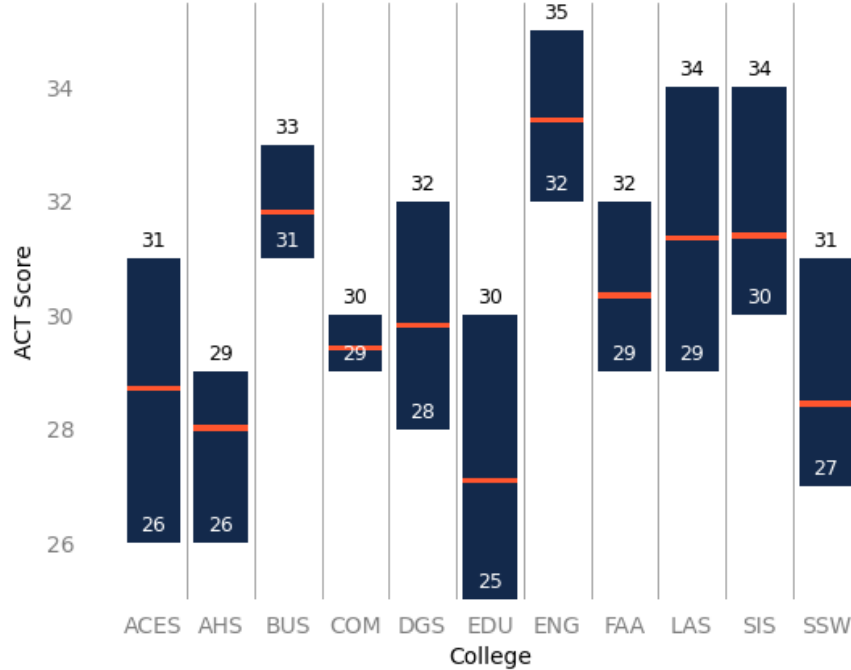

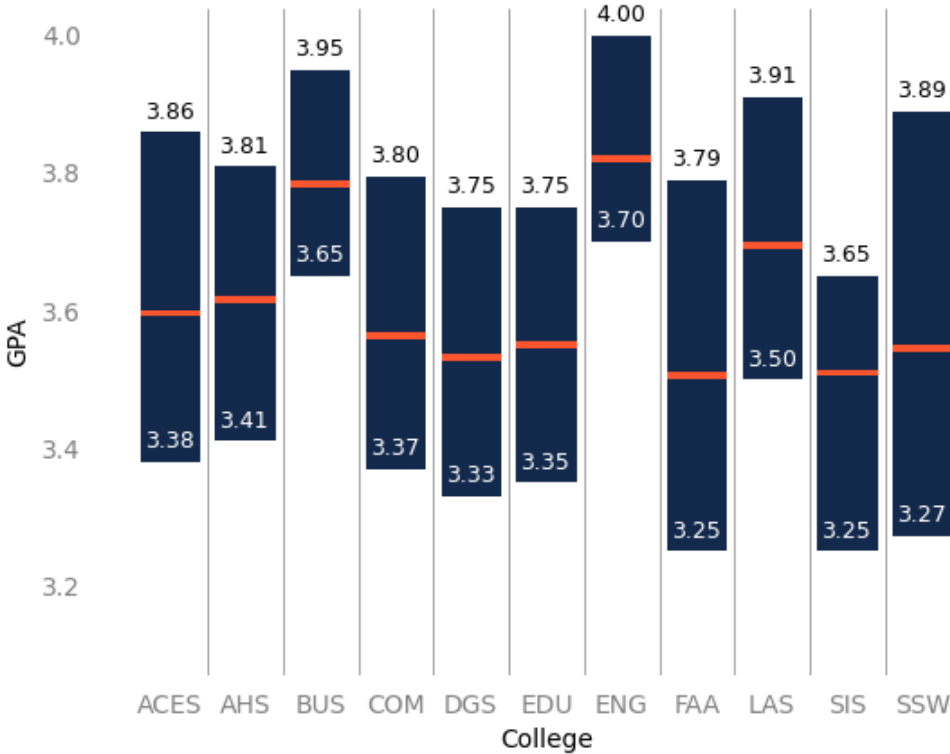
