














TOP 10 FEEDER STATES OUTSIDE OF ILLINOIS






TOP 10 FEEDER ILLINOIS COUNTIES



ENROLLMENT BY % US HIGH SCHOOL


% OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ATTENDING US HIGH SCHOOLS




FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT COUNT, INCLUDING % OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT






