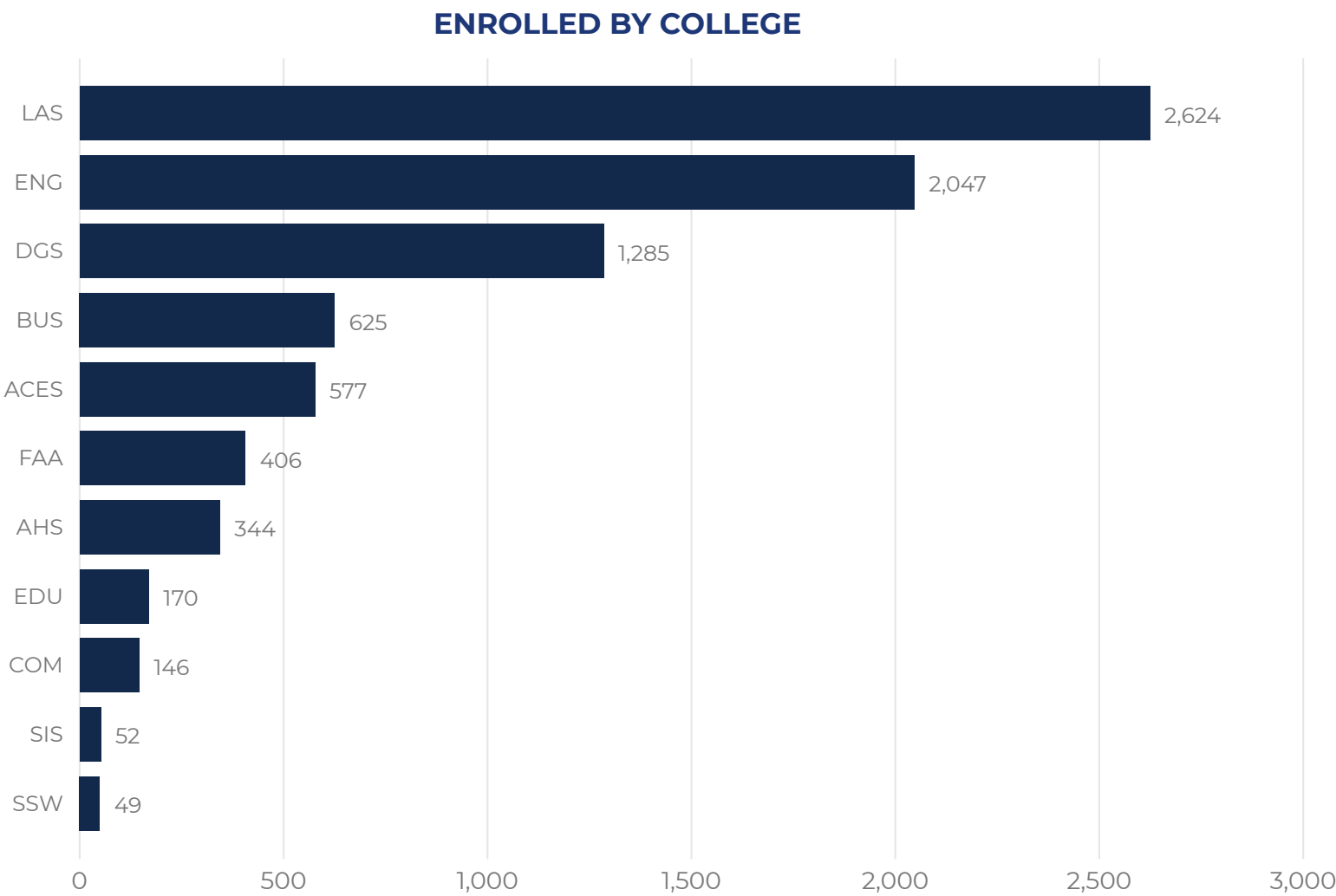

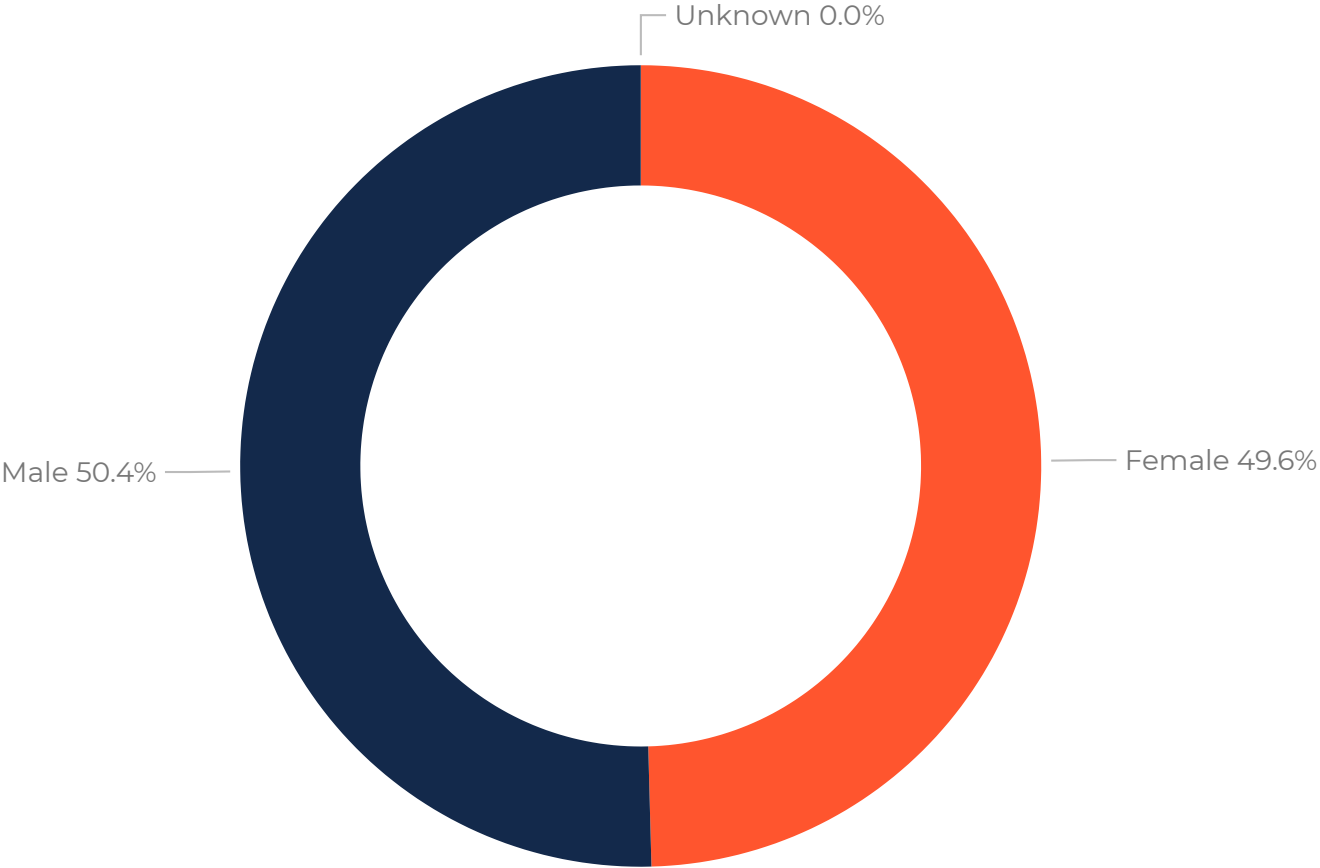

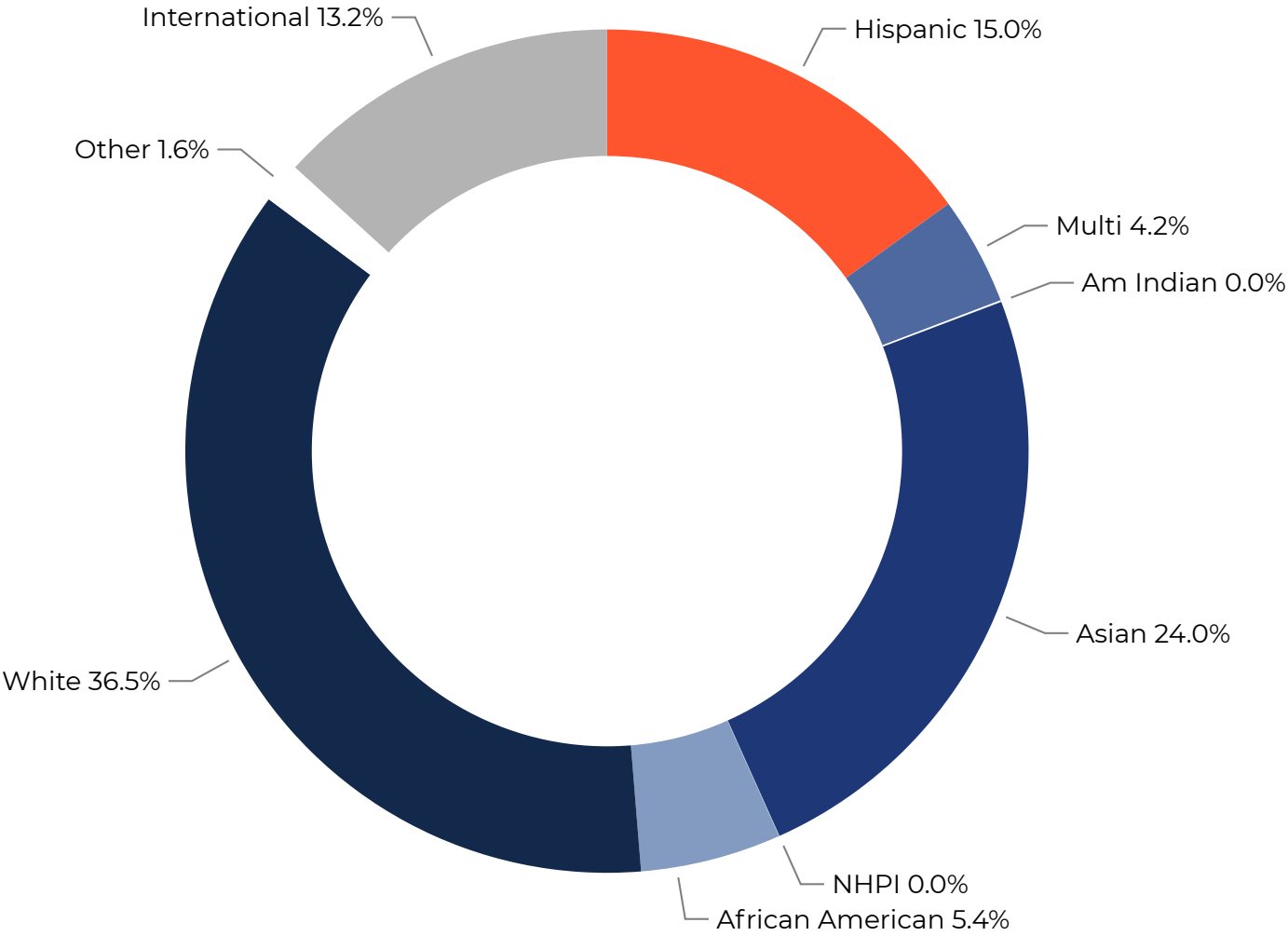

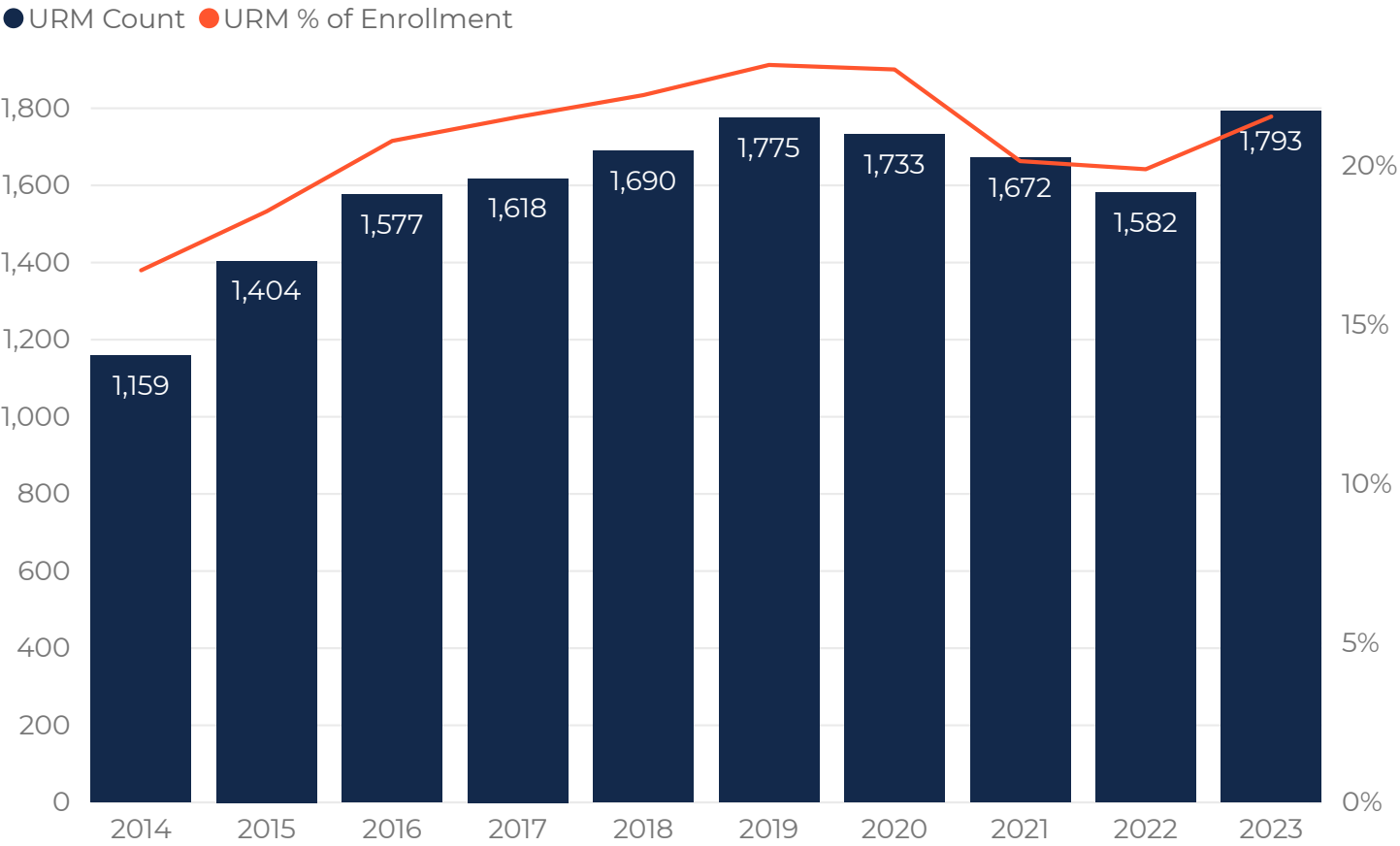

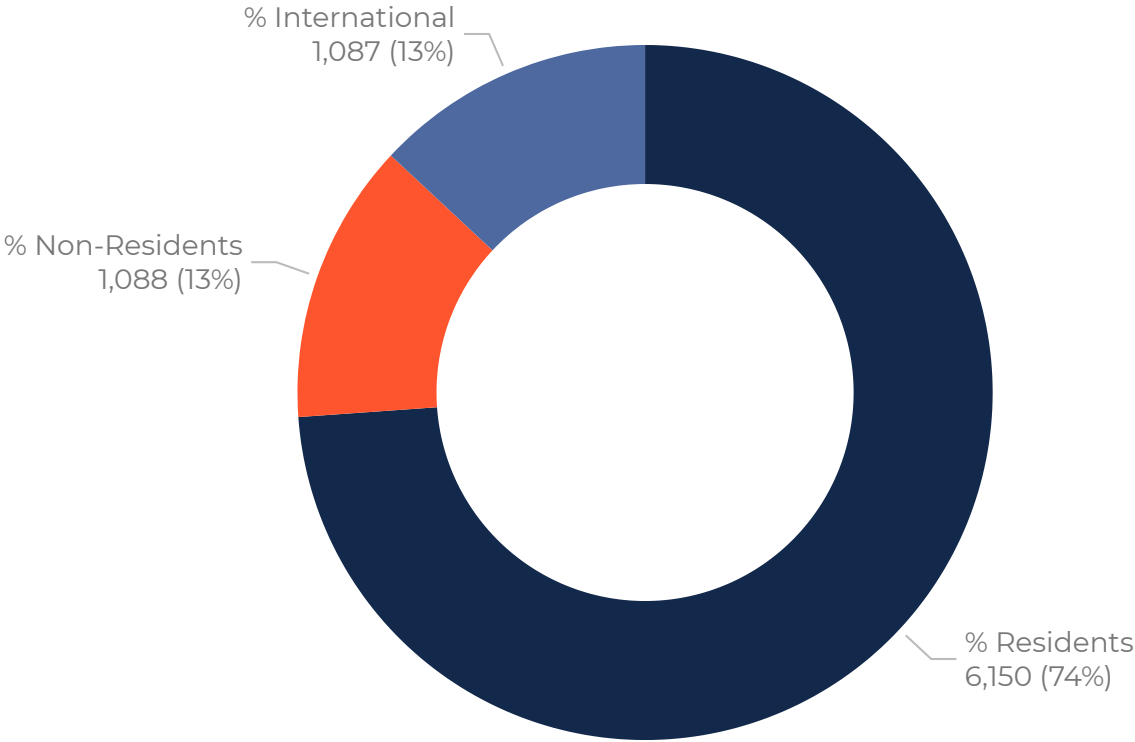

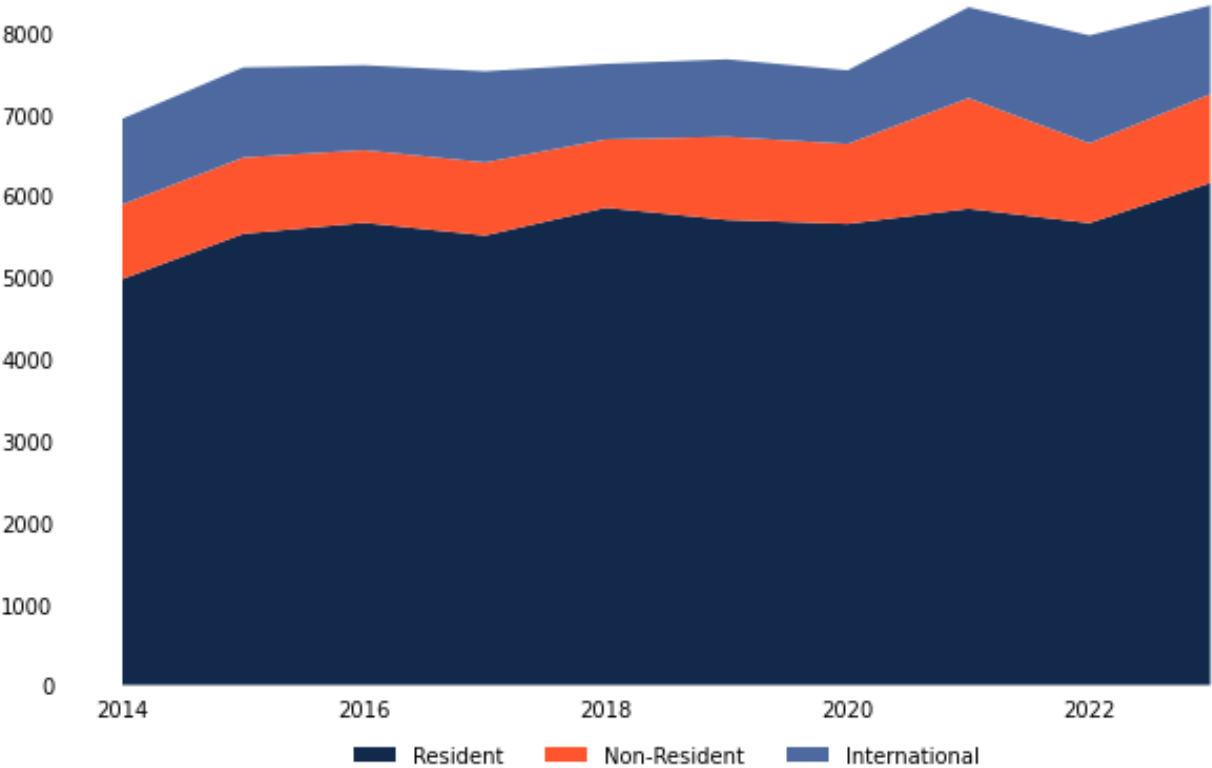

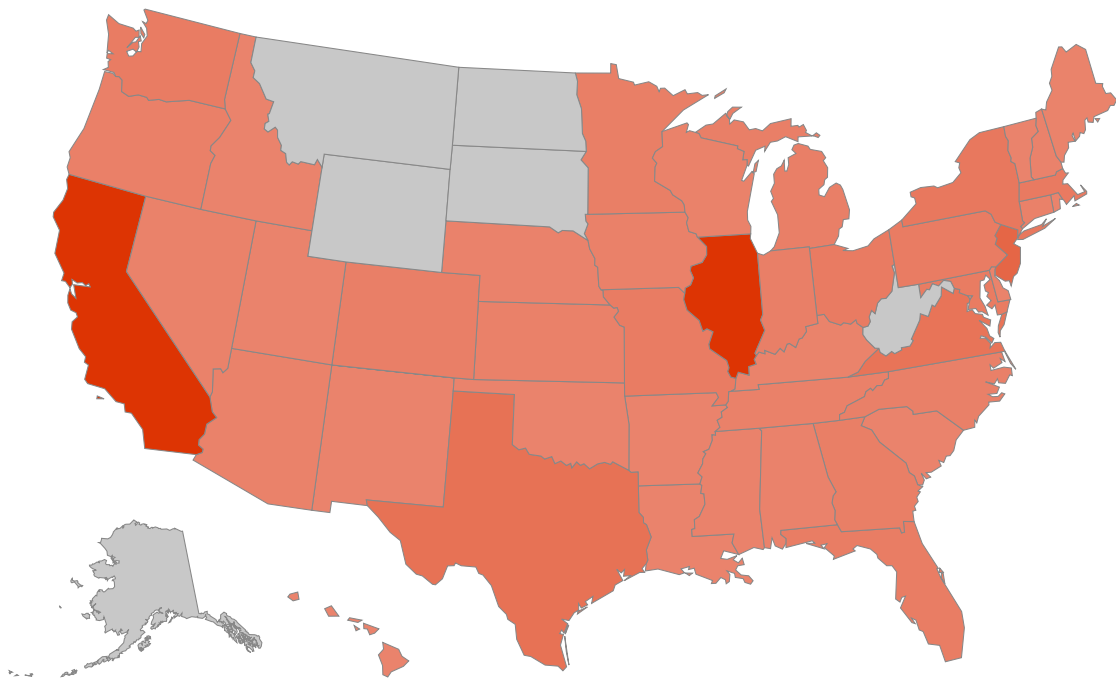

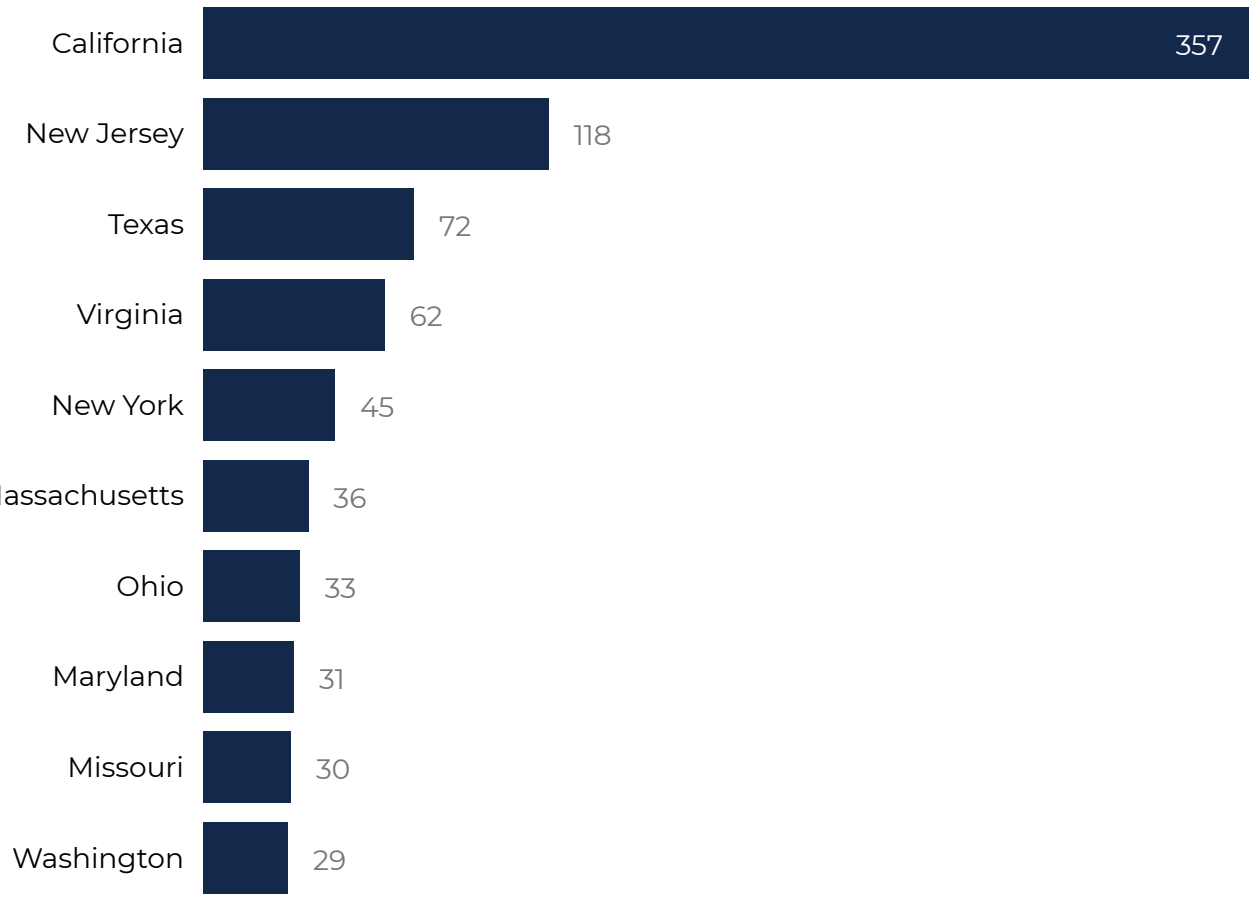

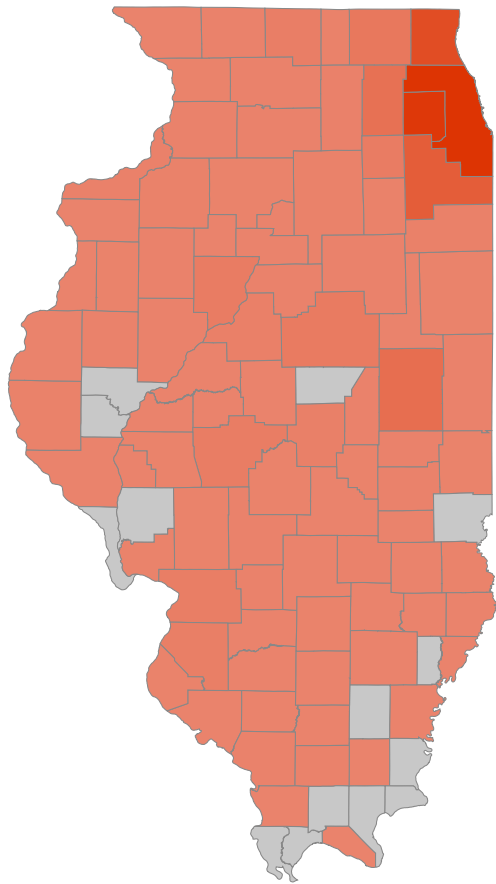
TOP 10 FEEDER STATES OUTSIDE OF ILLINOIS

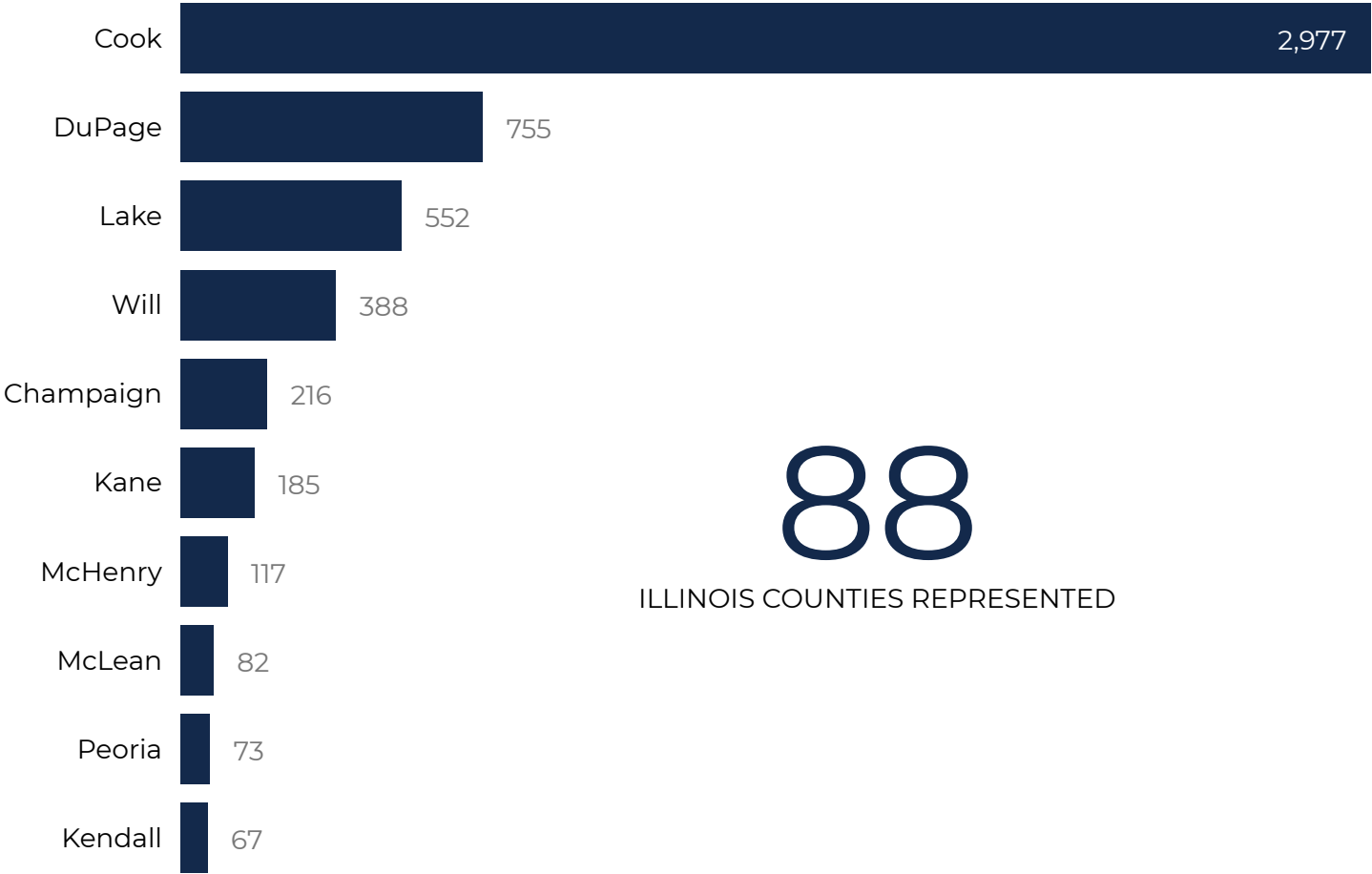

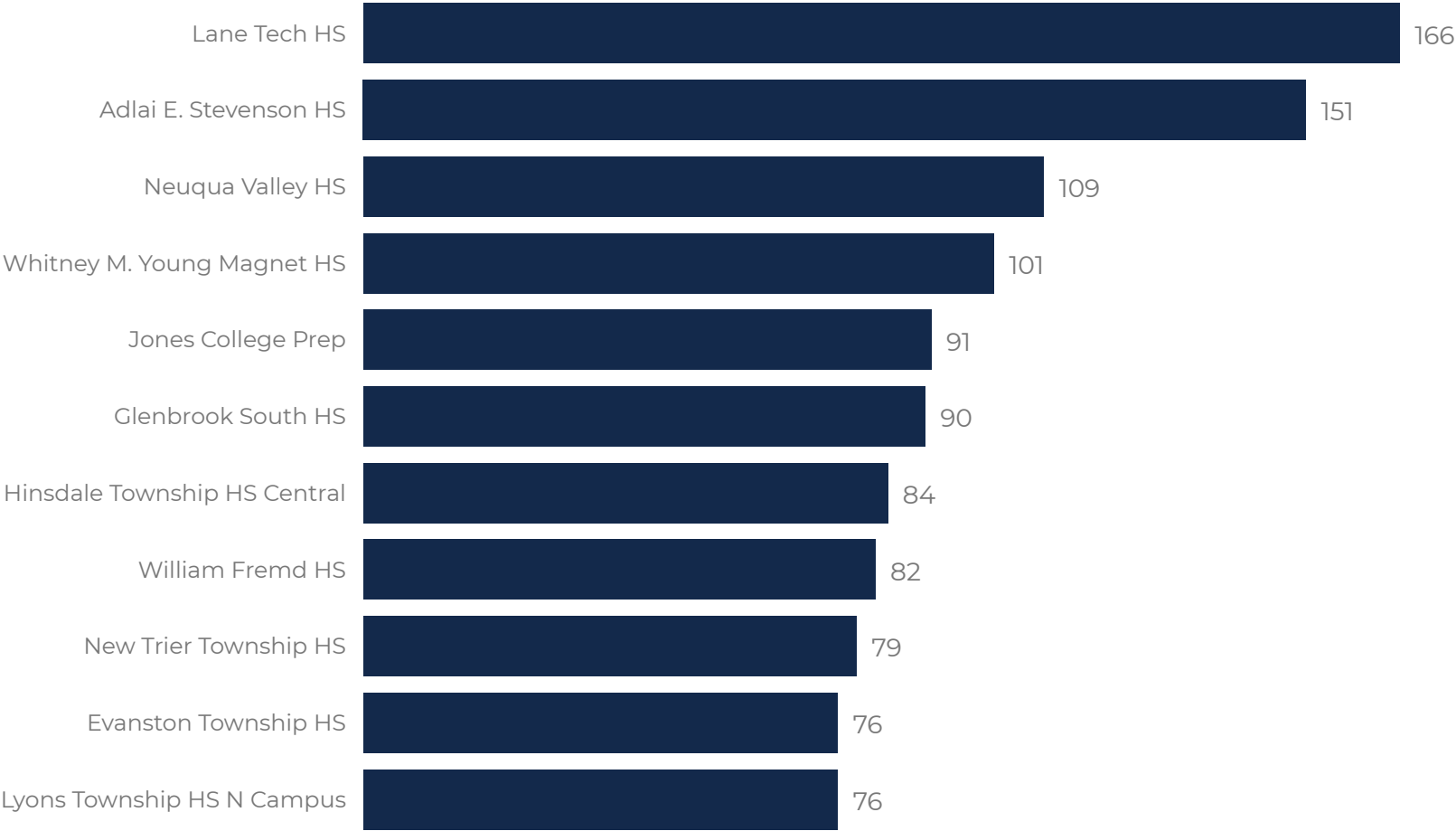

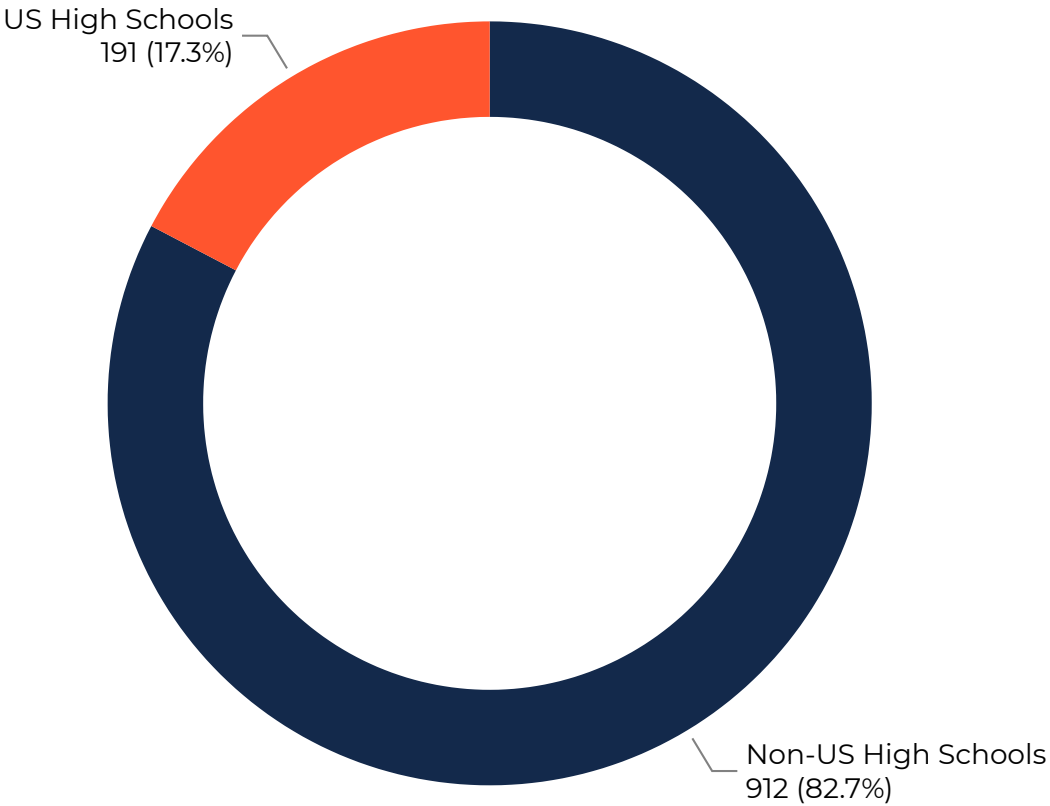

ENROLLMENT BY % US HIGH SCHOOL

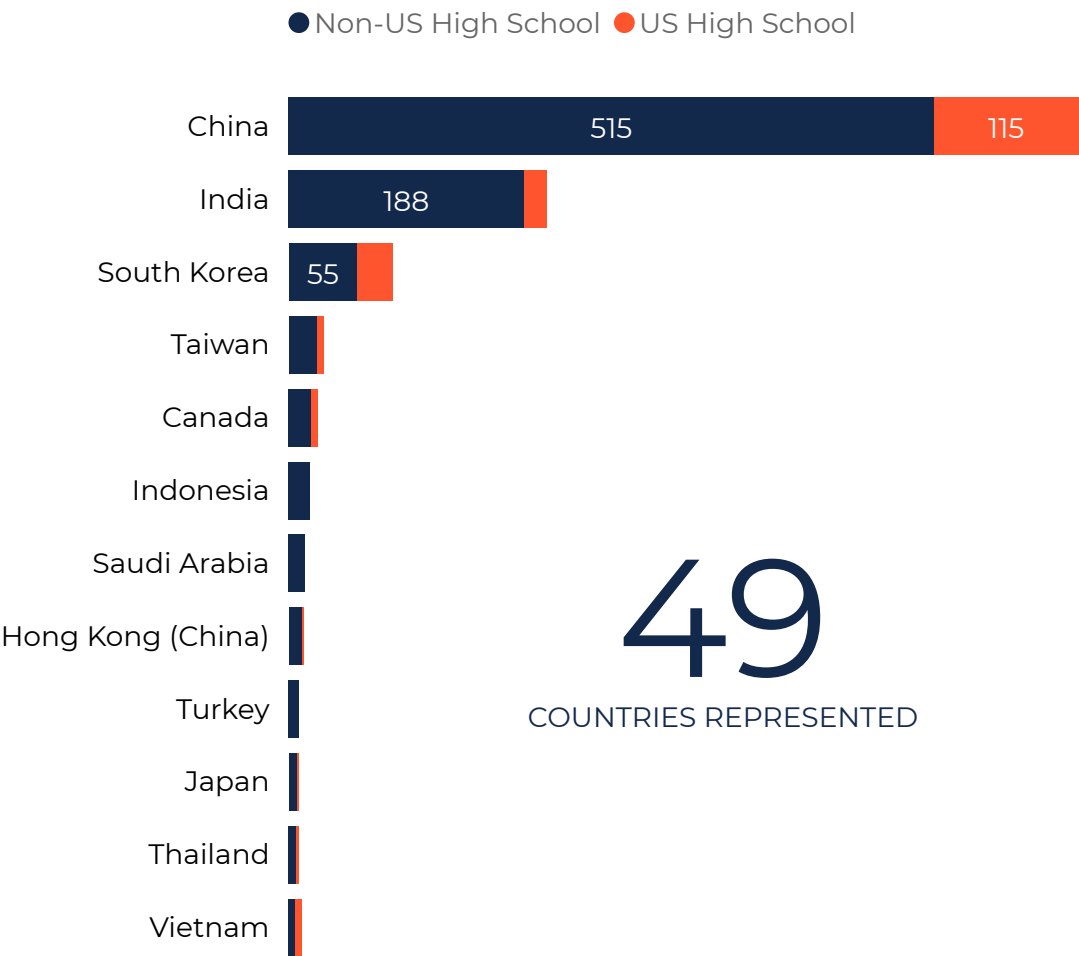
% OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ATTENDING US HIGH SCHOOLS

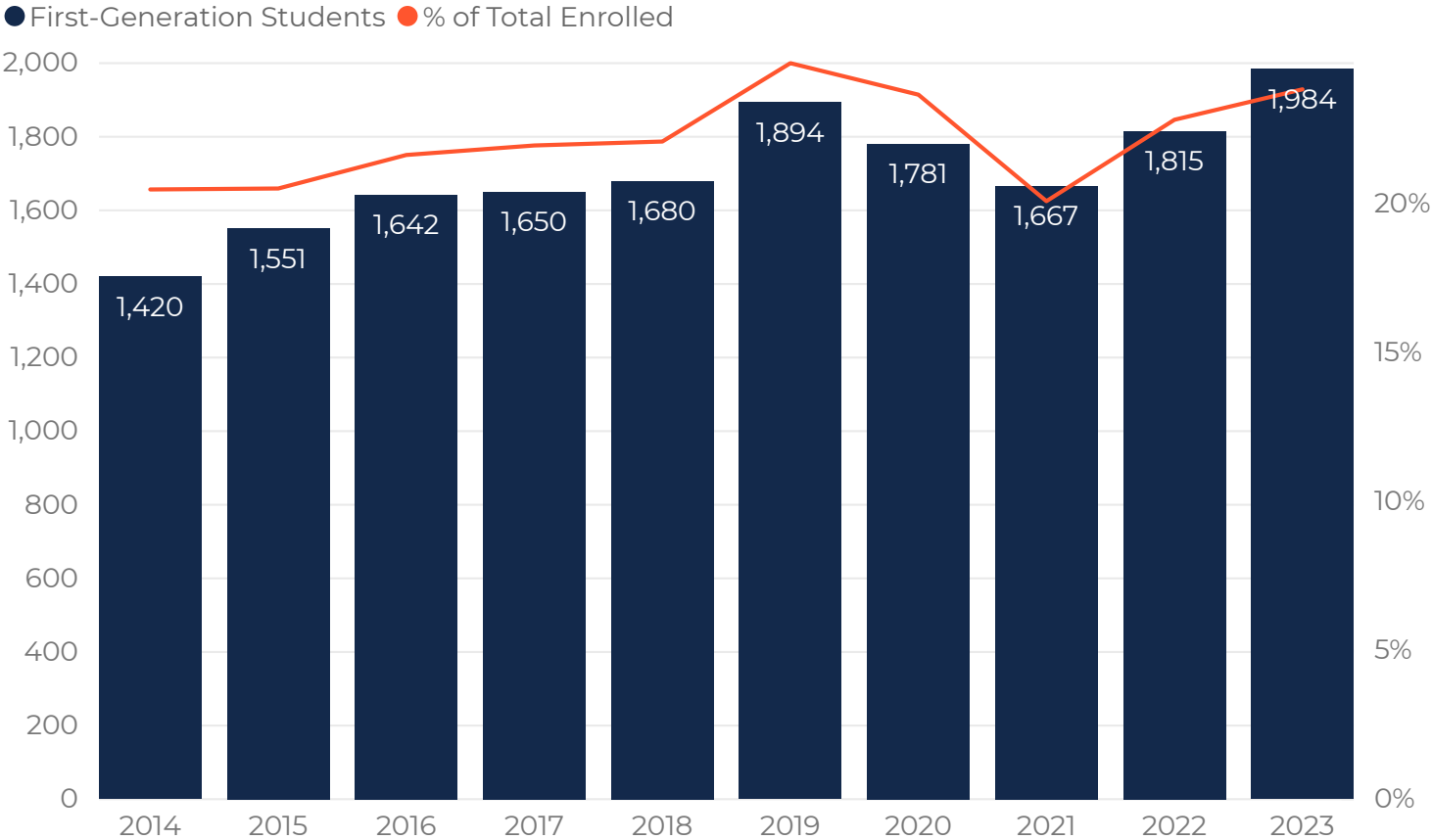

FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT COUNT, INCLUDING % OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT



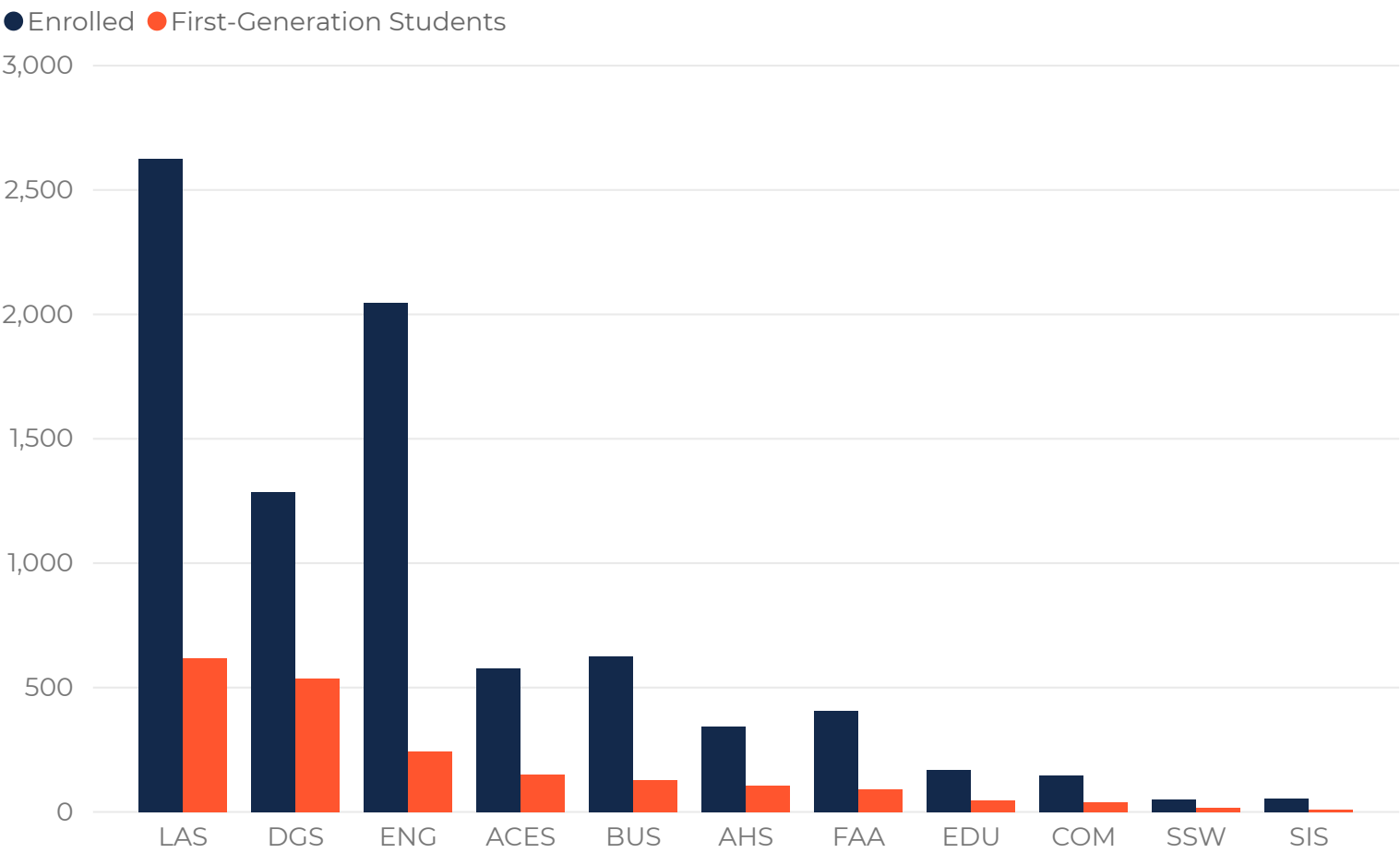

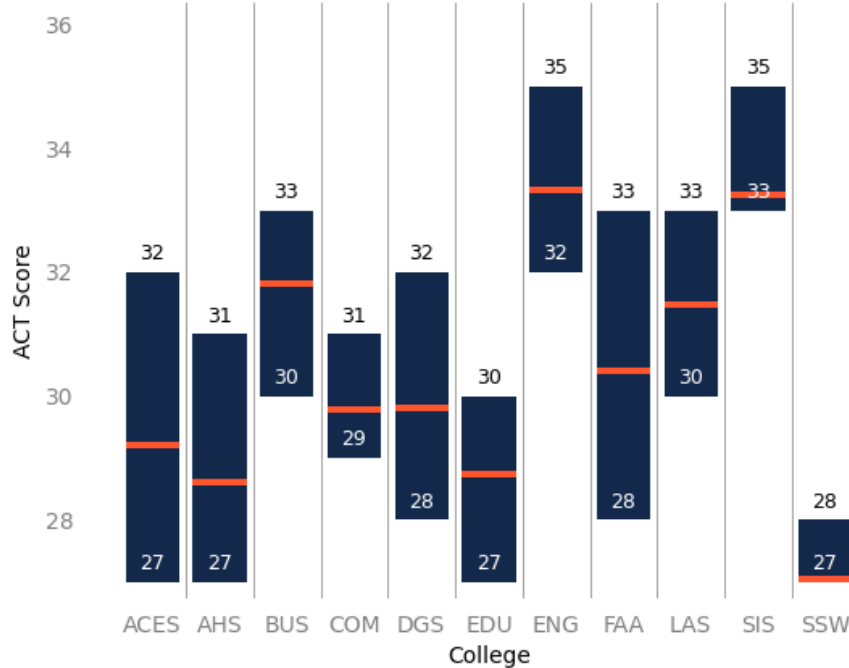

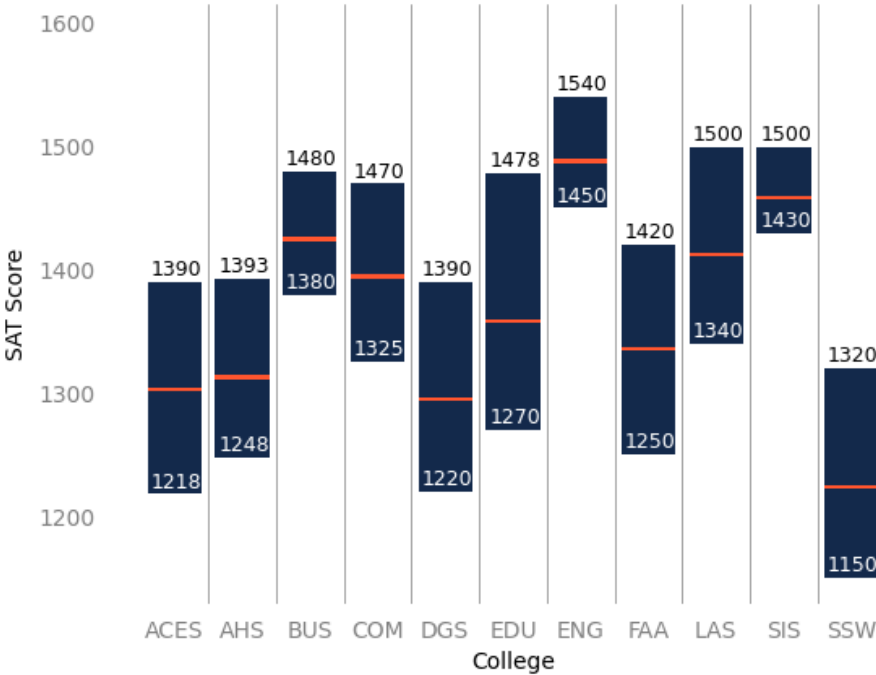

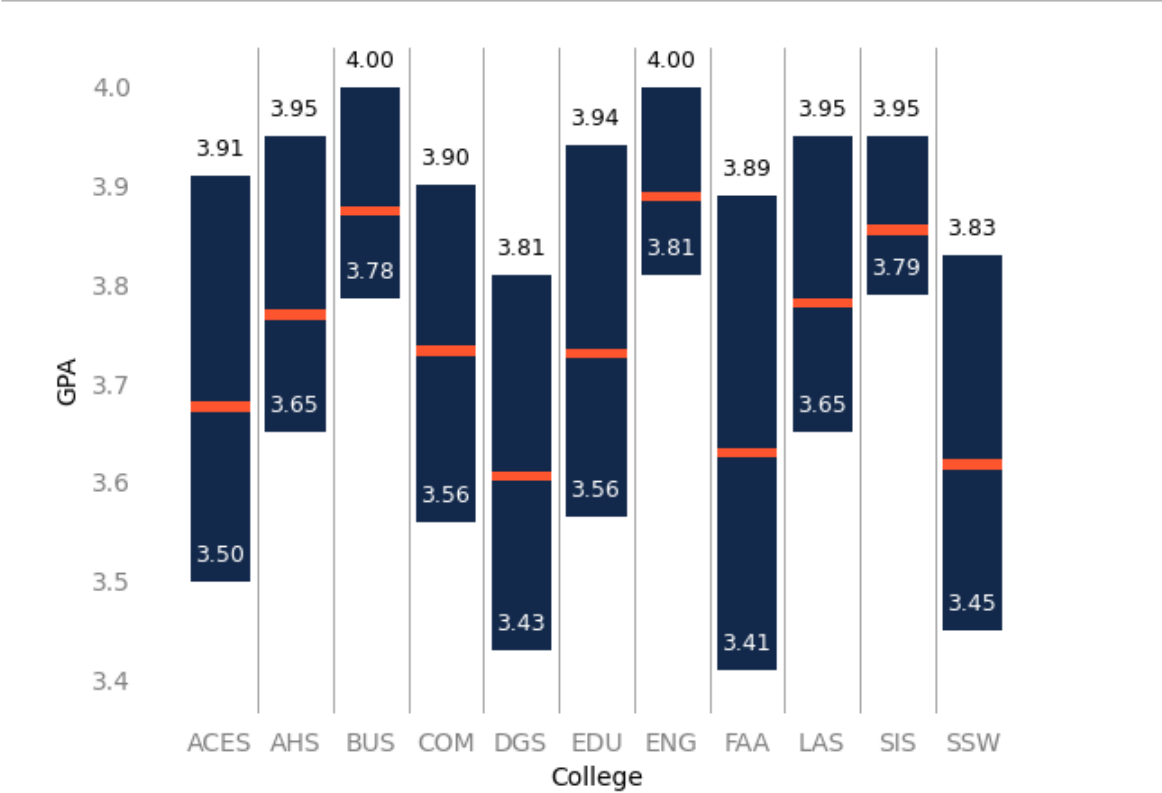
