
















ENROLLMENT BY INSTITUTION LOCATION





FIRST-GENERATION ENROLLMENT


FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT COUNT, INCLUDING % OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT

FIRST-GENERATION STUDENTS ENROLLMENT COUNT BY COLLEGE




ENROLLMENT BY AVERAGE GPA






ILLINOIS ENROLLMENT *
