





#### **COUNT AND % OF UNDERREPRESENTED MINORITIES OVER TIME**














#### **ENROLLMENT BY INSTITUTION LOCATION**


#### FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT COUNT, INCLUDING % OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT


