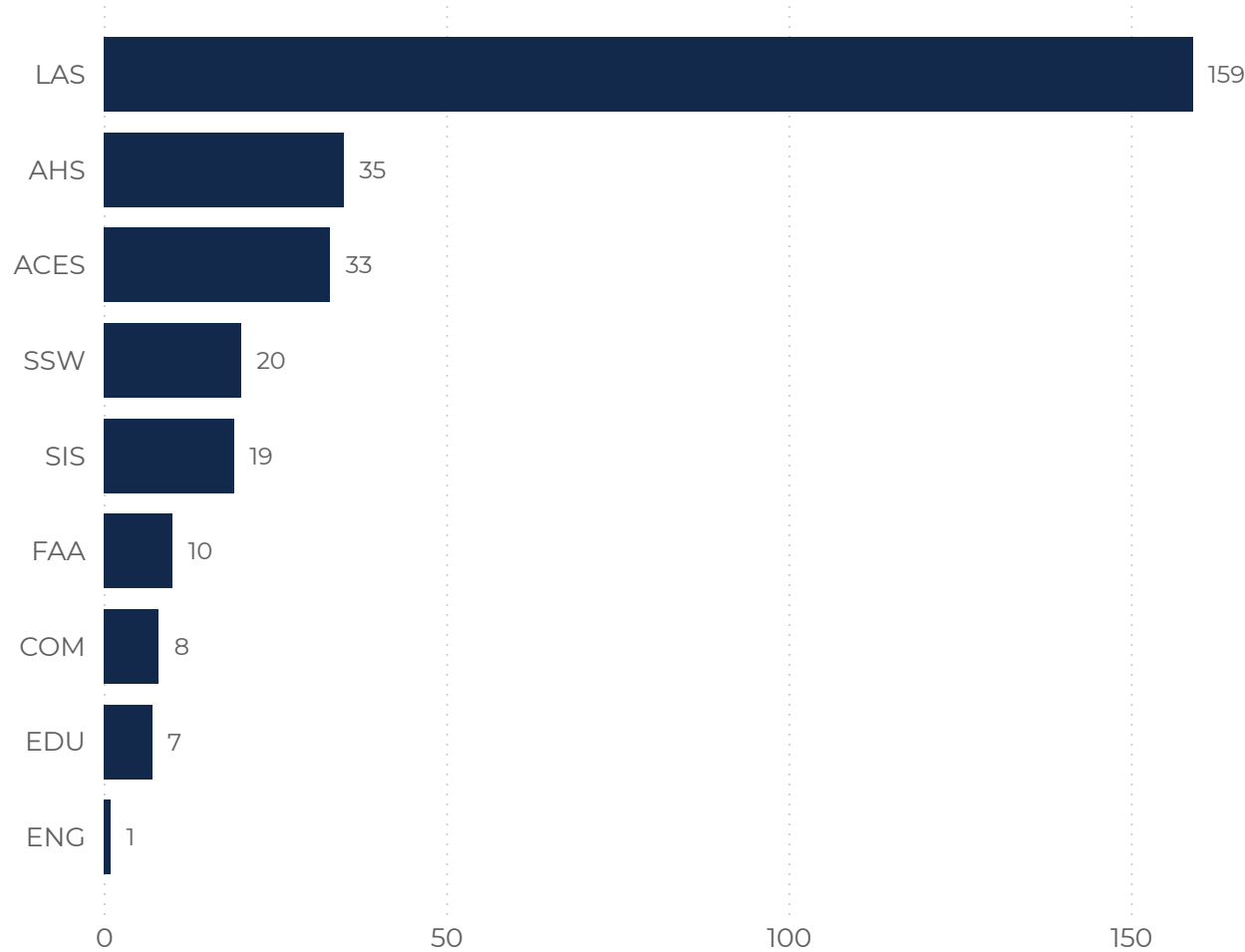

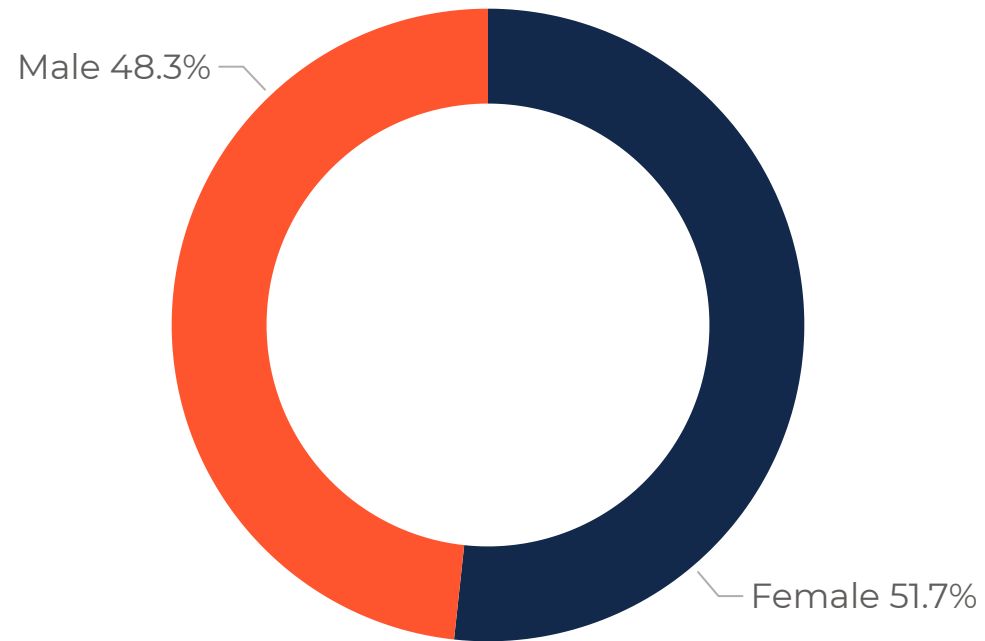

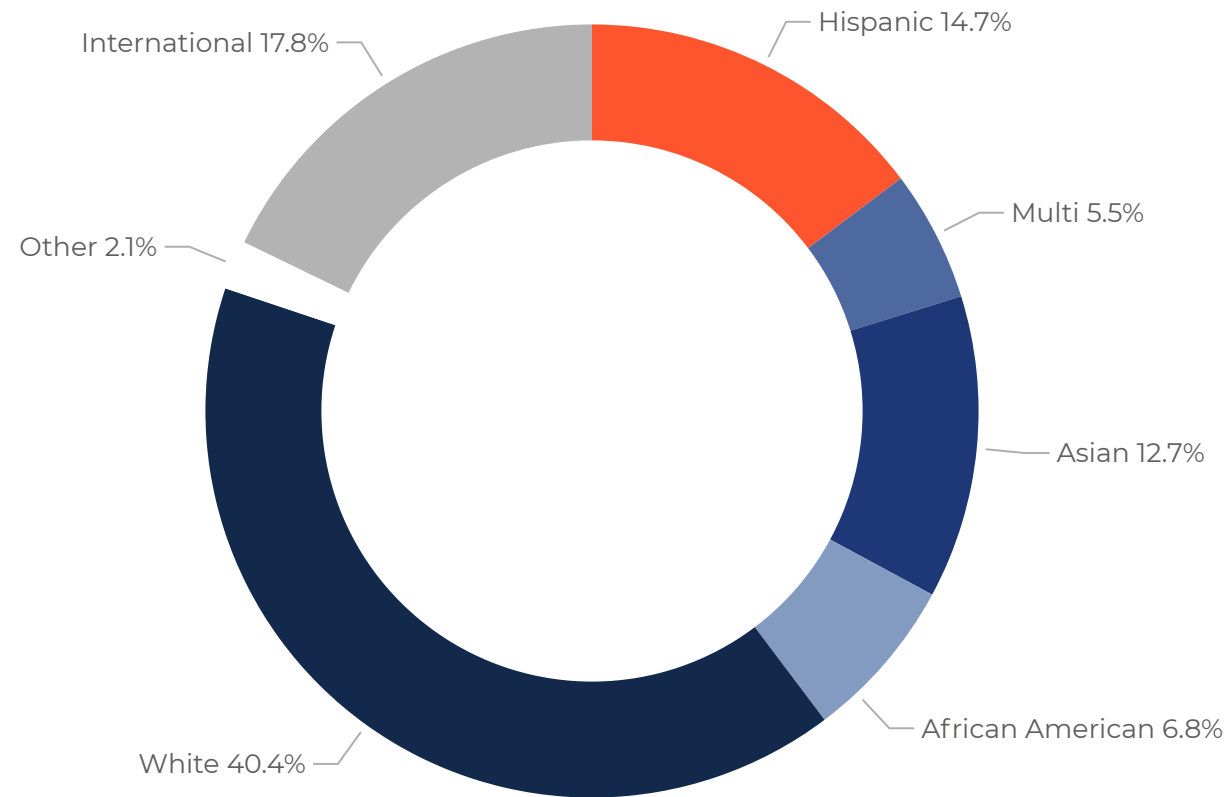

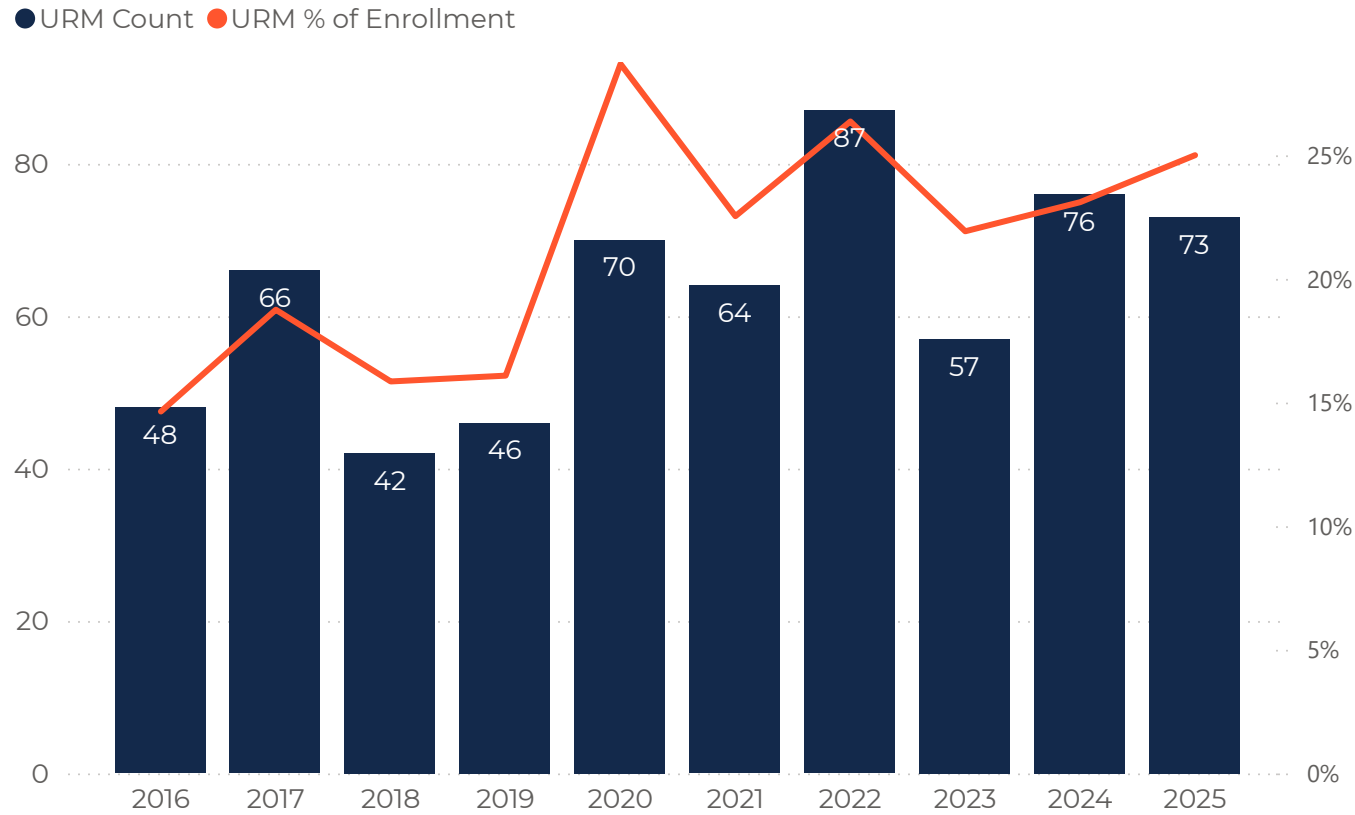

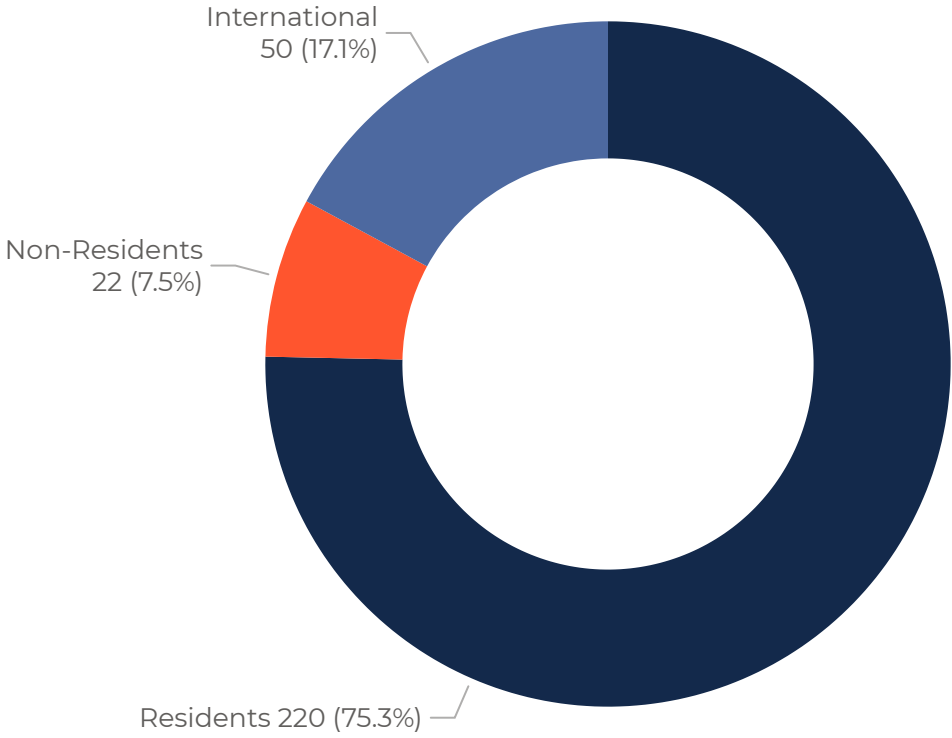

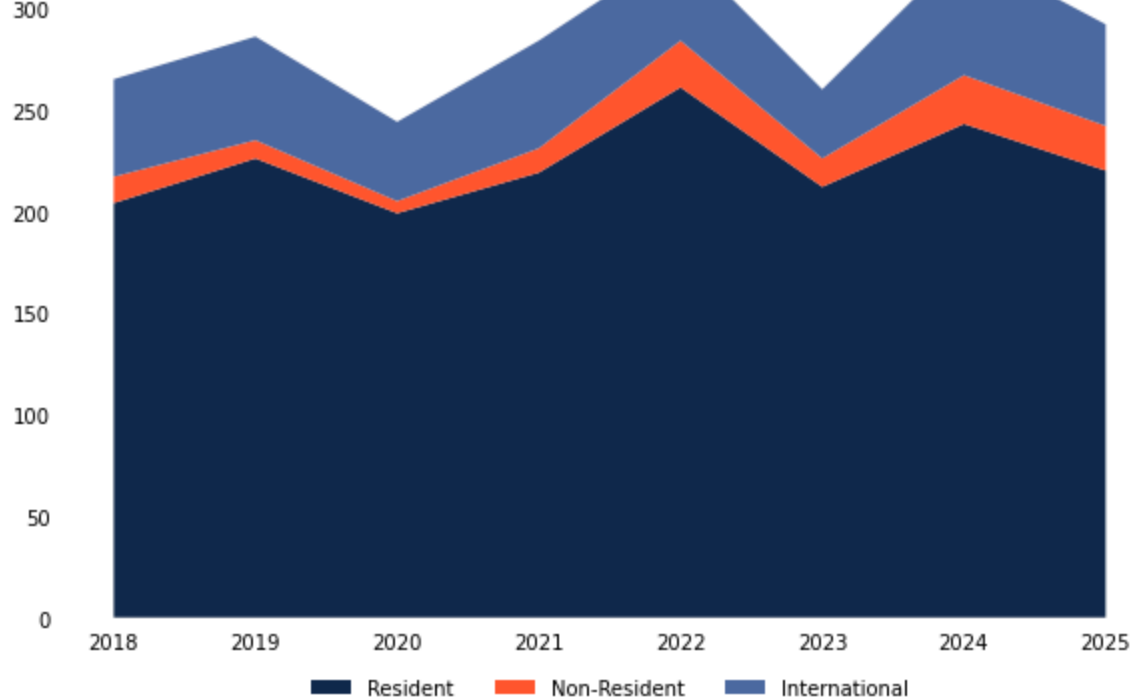

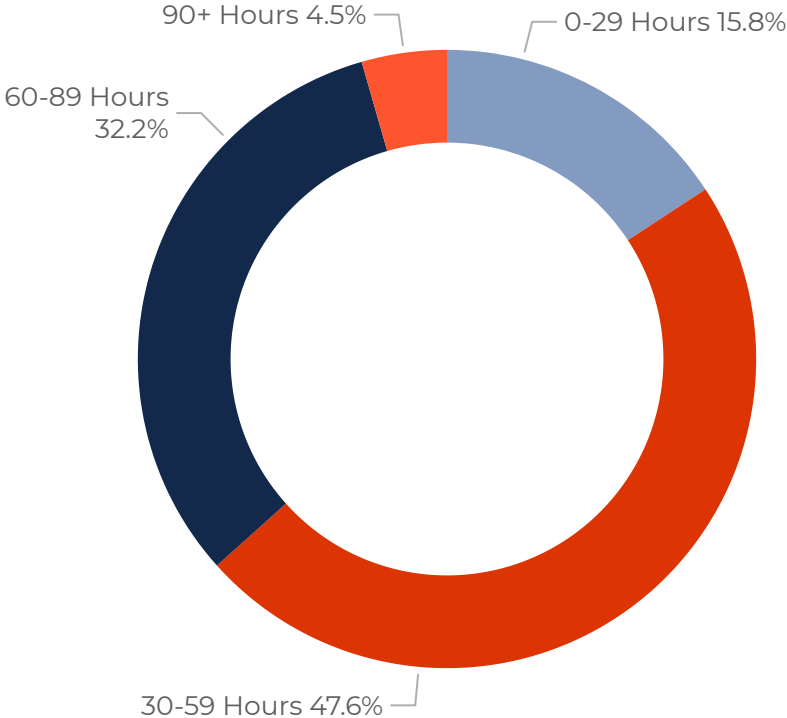

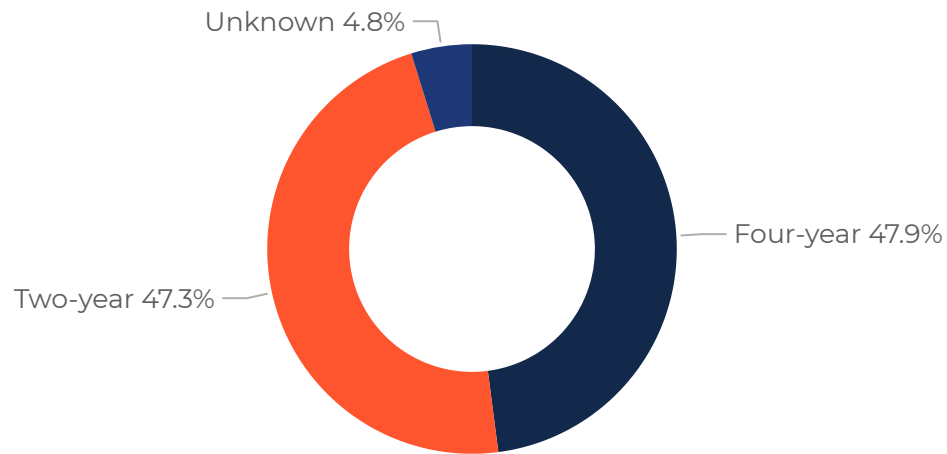

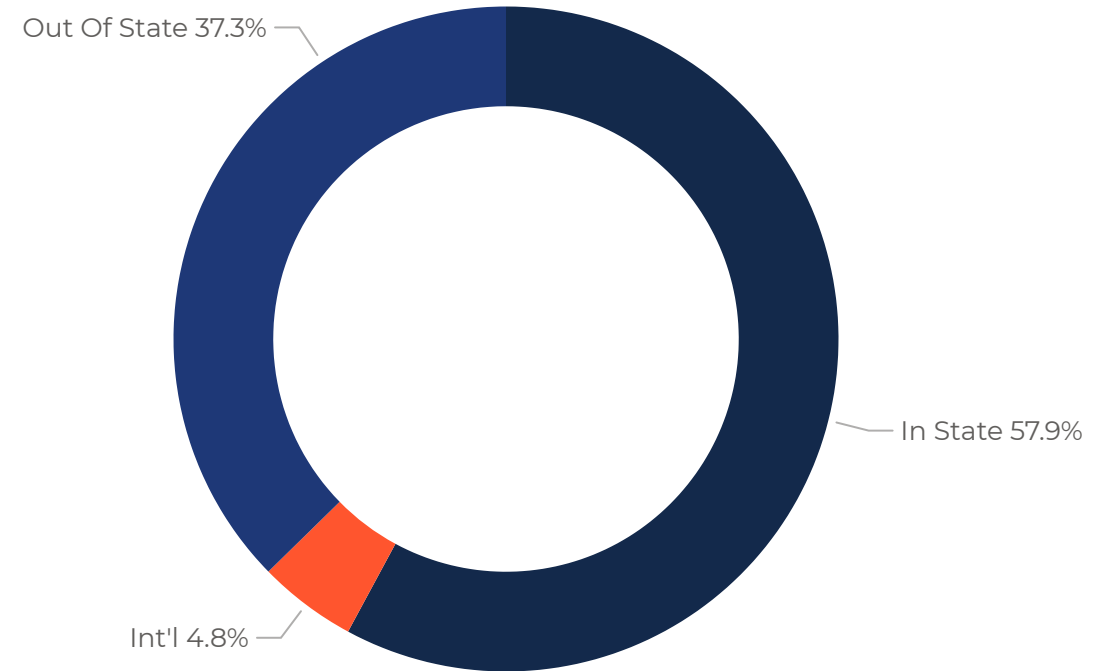

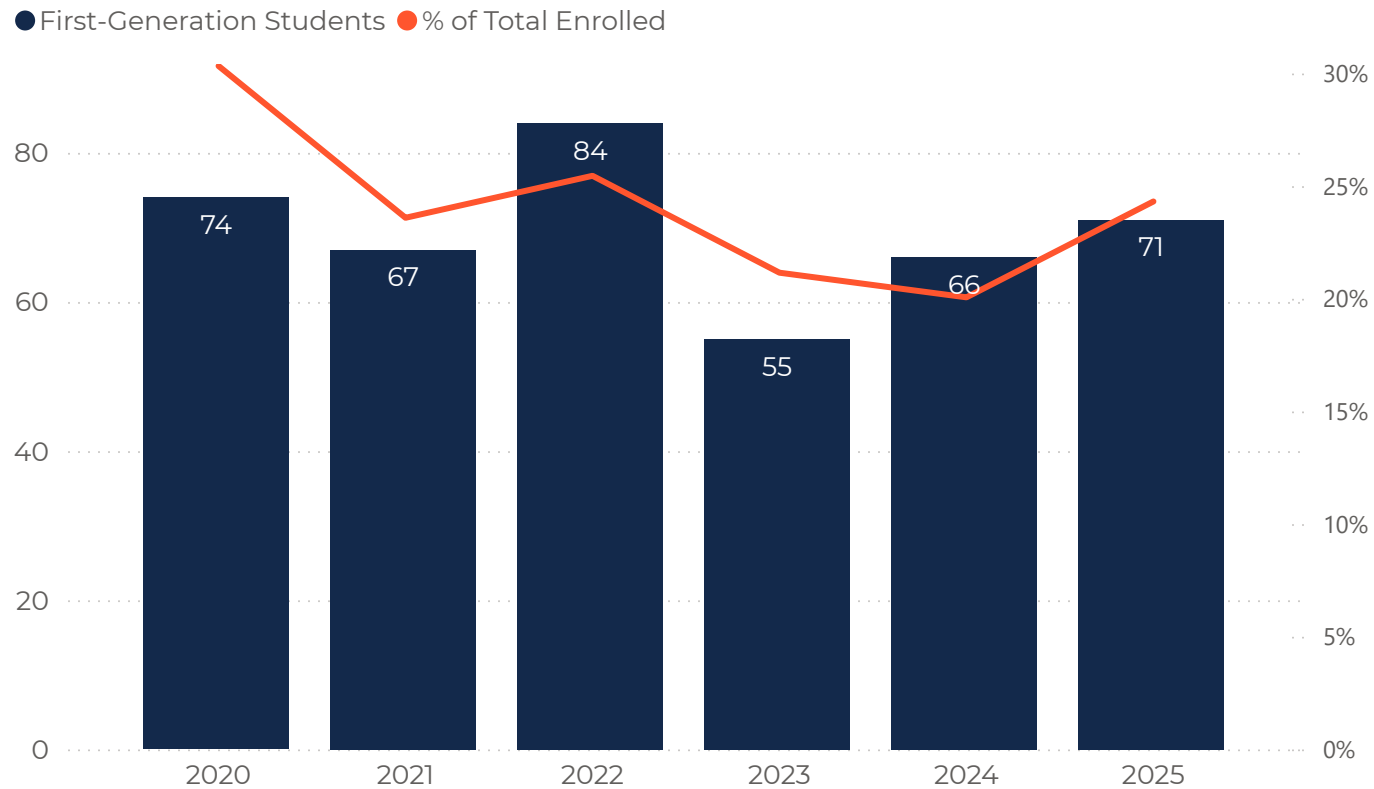


ENROLLMENT BY INSTITUTION LOCATION



FIRST-GENERATION ENROLLMENT

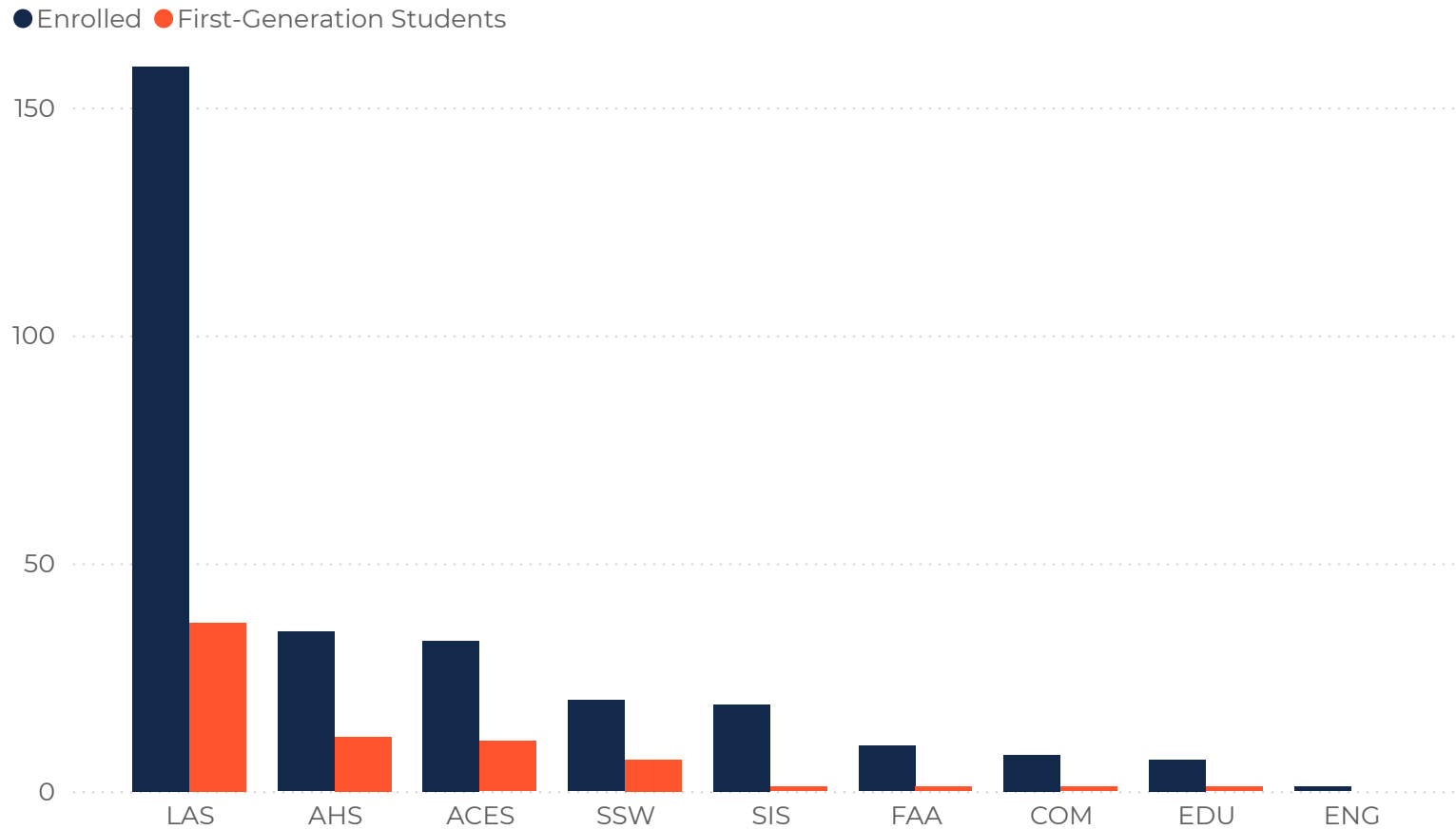
FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT COUNT, INCLUDING % OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT

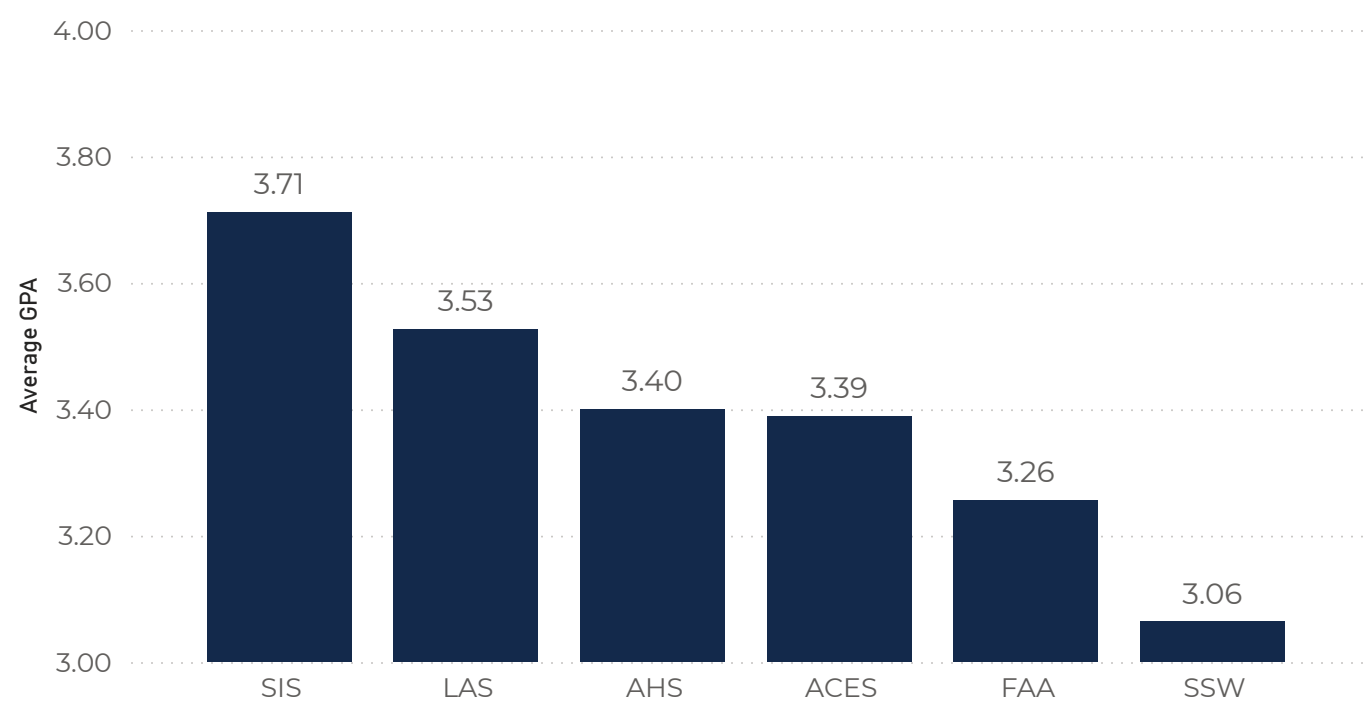

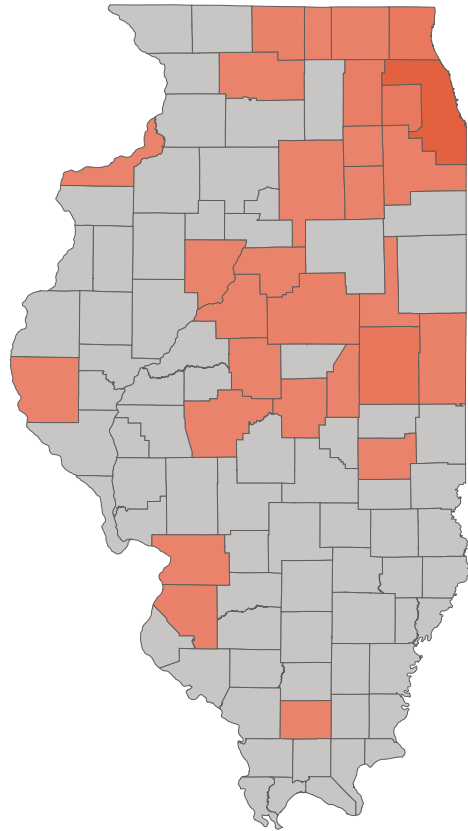

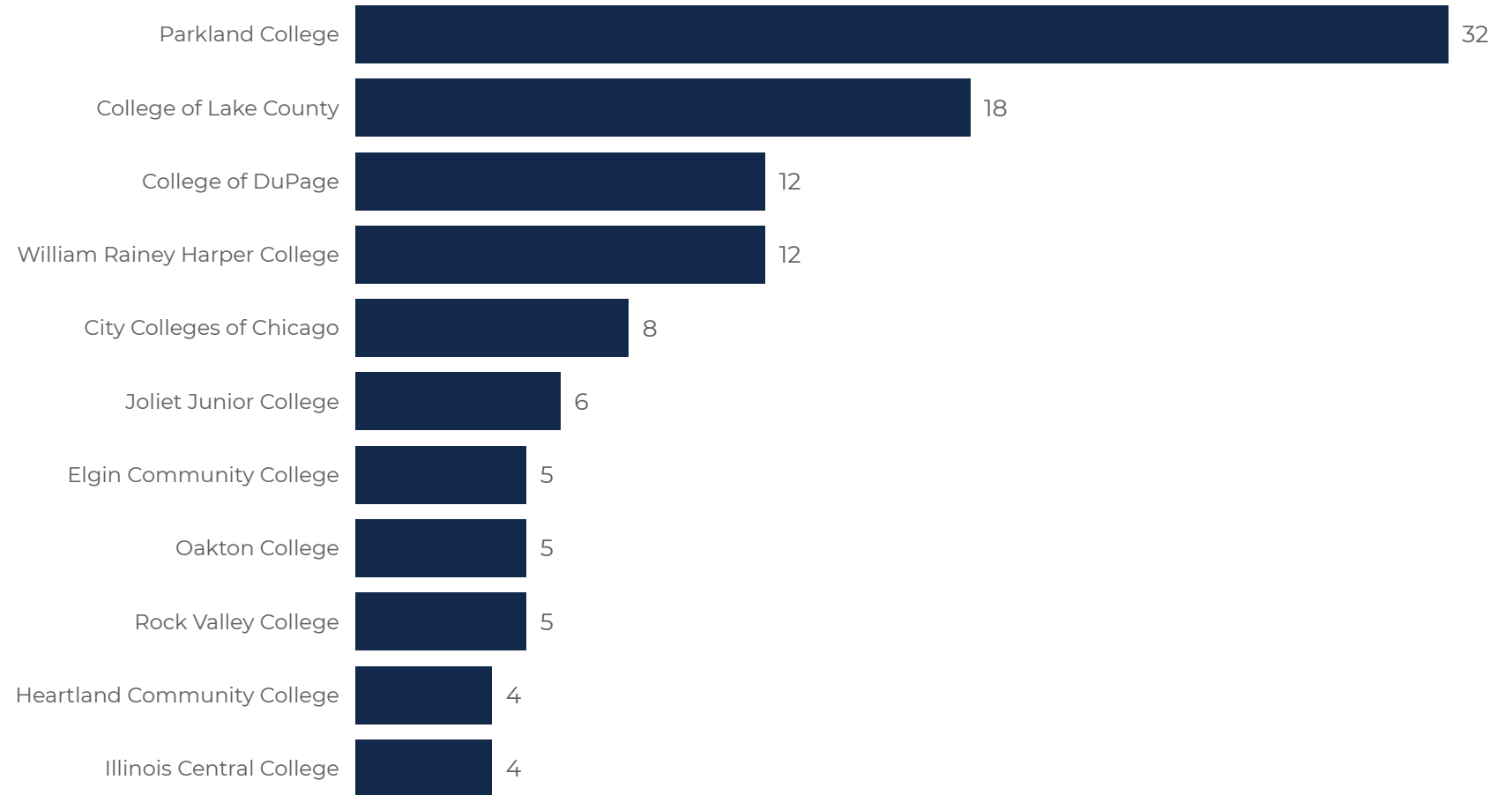


ILLINOIS ENROLLMENT *

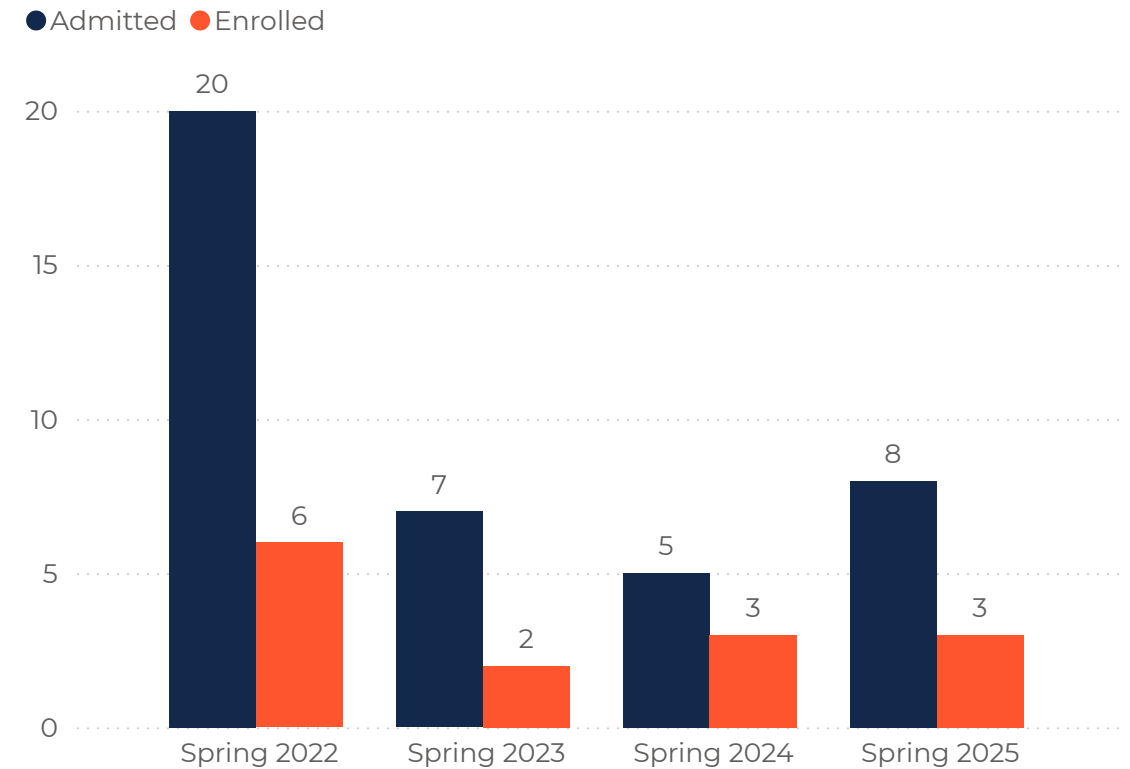
